

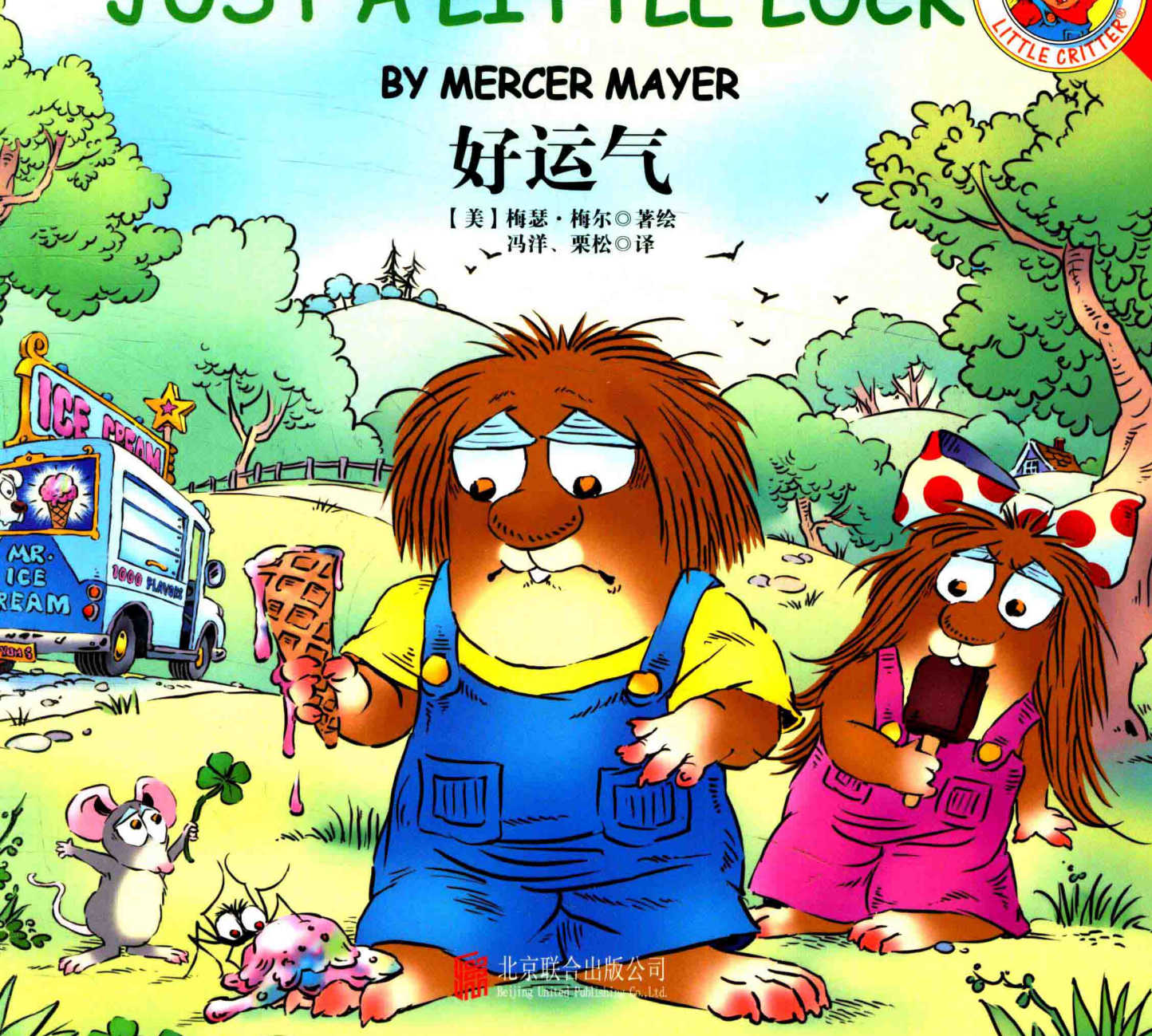

I found a penny. I thought it would give me luck.

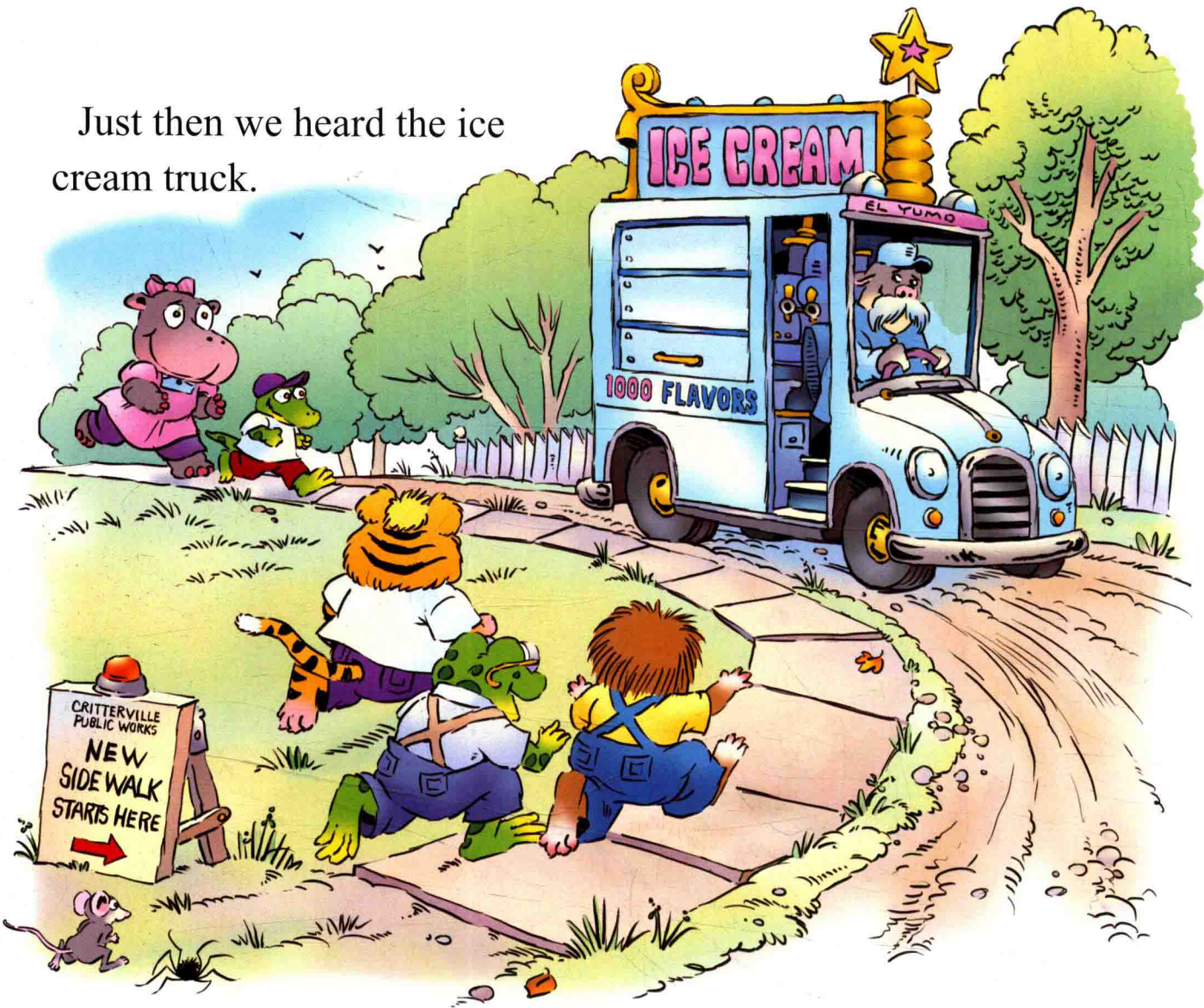
“Was it heads or tails?” asked Tiger.

Just then we heard the ice cream truck.



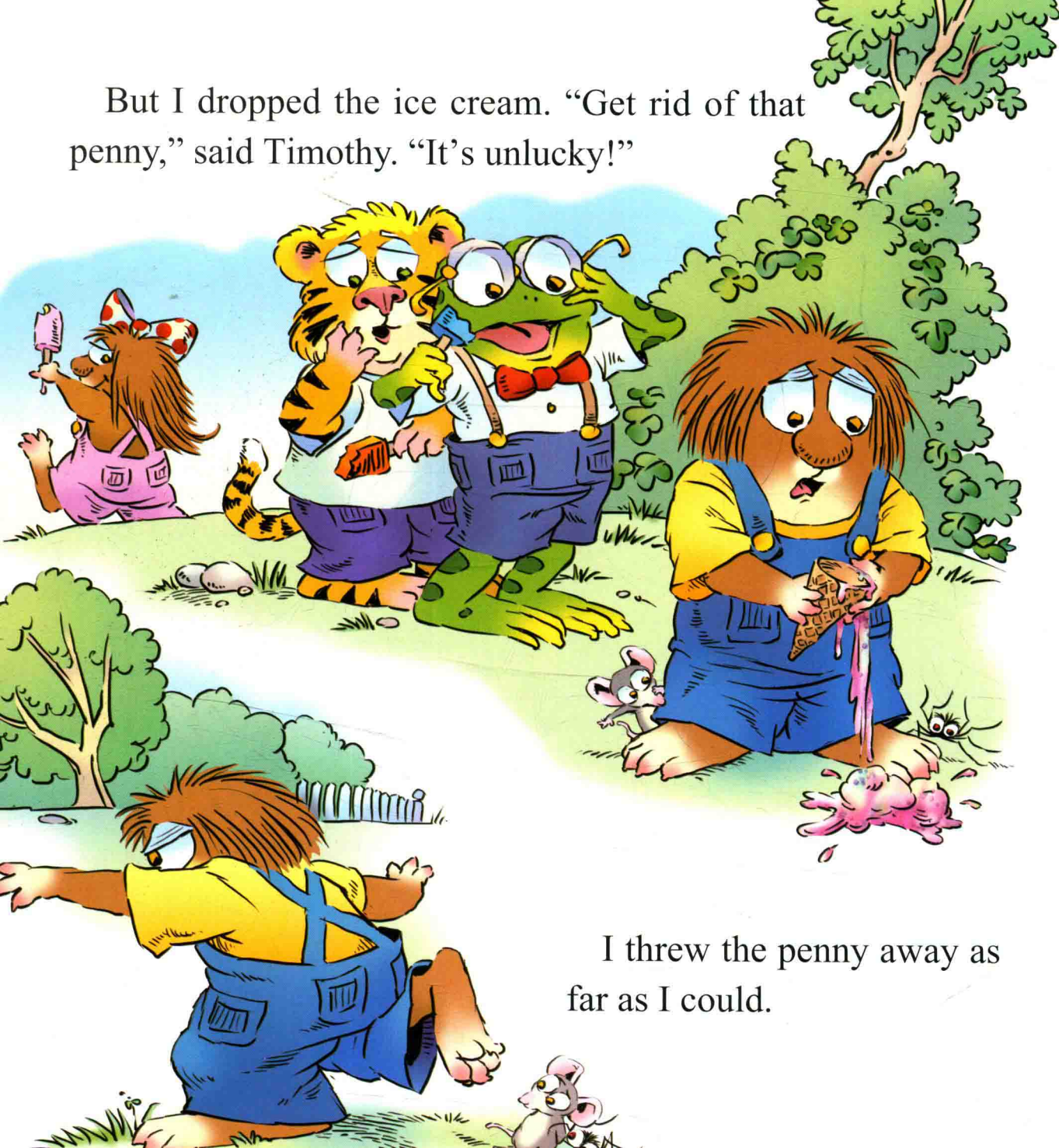
I wanted a double critterberry cone.

But I dropped the ice cream. "Get rid of that penny," said Timothy. "It's unlucky!"

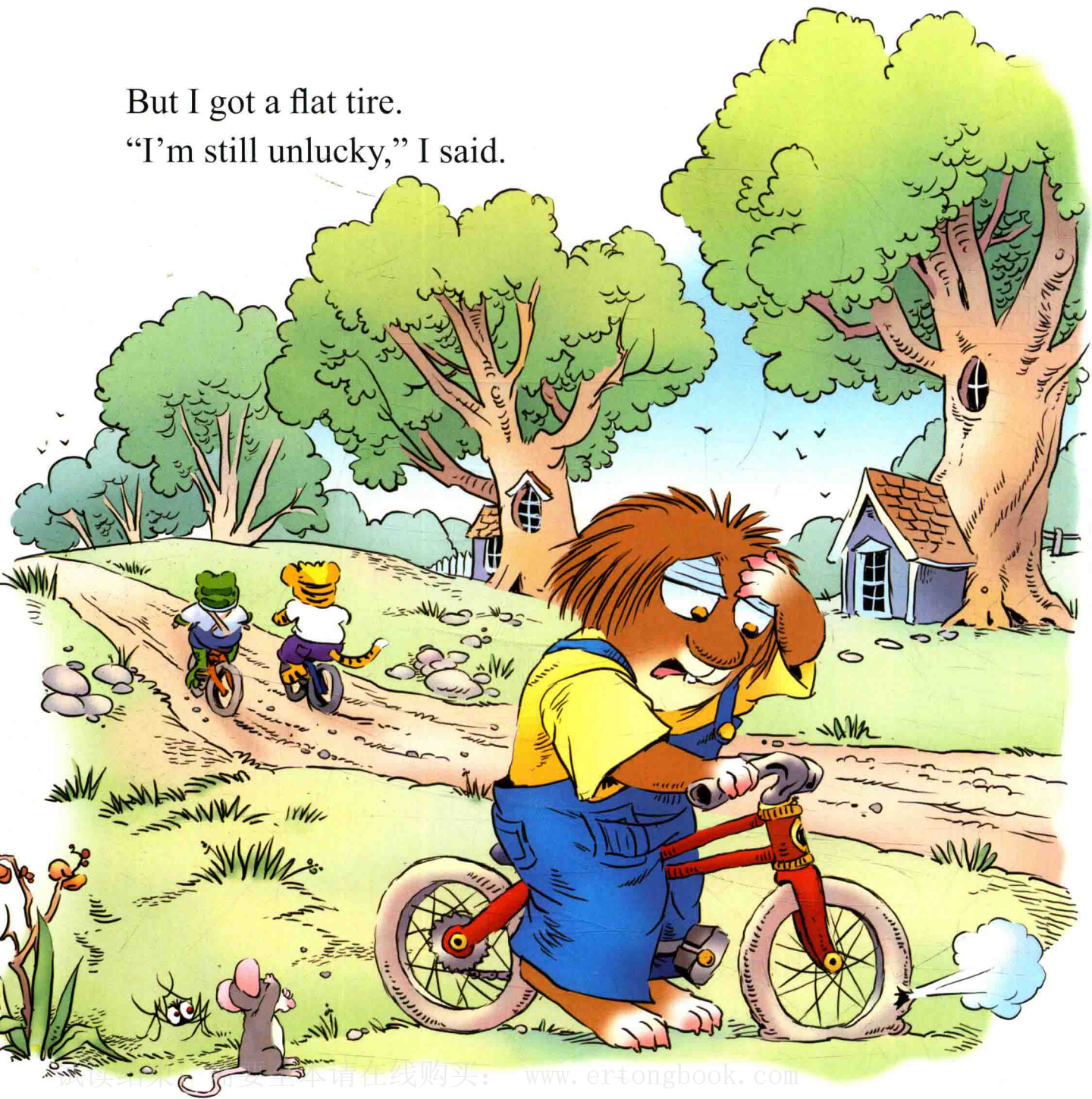


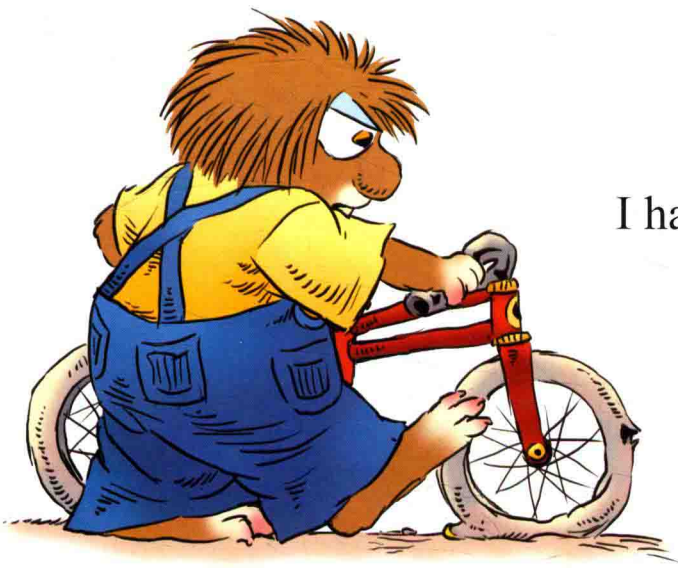
I threw the penny away as far as I could.



I felt better, and soon it was time to go home.

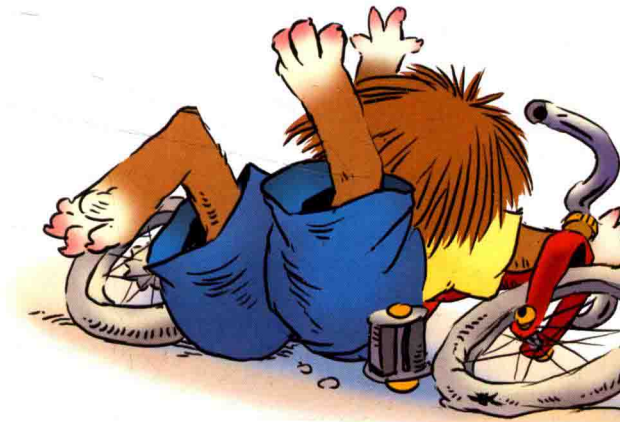
But I got a flat tire.

fell down.

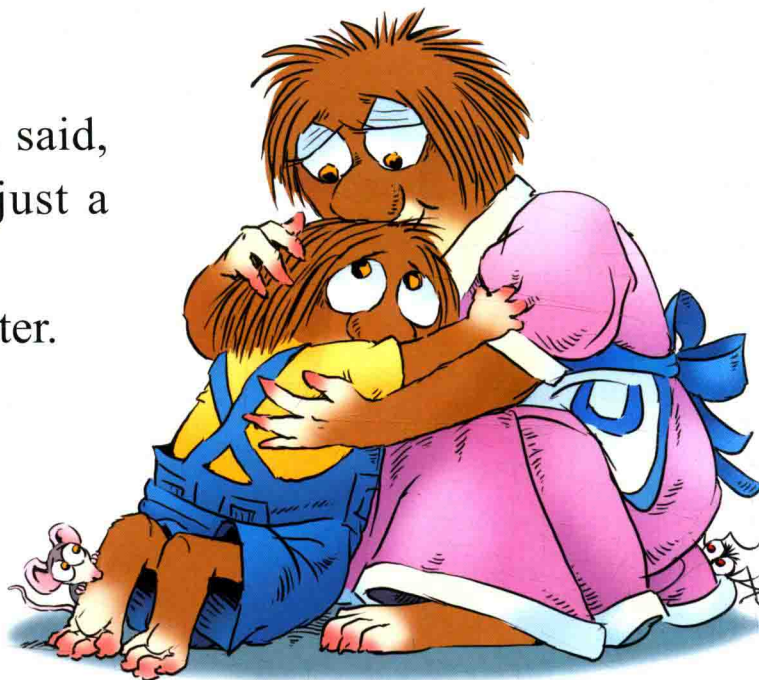


I was having a very unlucky day.

That night I took a long bath.

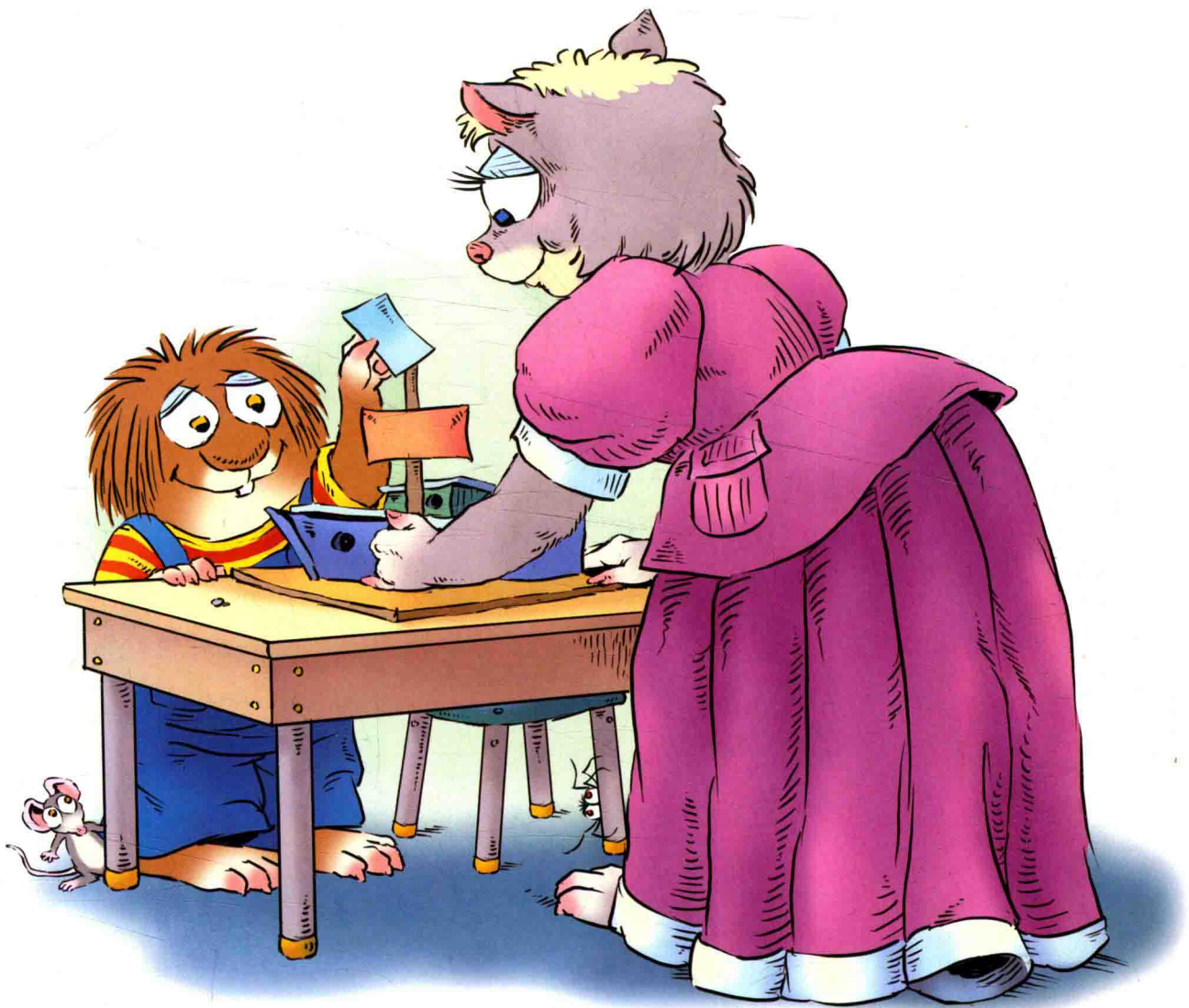


Then I finished my project due for school
