Nowadays, Shanghai is striving to become an economic, financial, trading and shipping center of the world.

According to the outline of national and Shanghai program for Long-term and Medium-term Education Reform and Development, the expansion of international exchange and cooperation has become the inevitable trend of Shanghai educational internationalization. Studying in China is one of the most effective ways to enhance the other nations' understanding of China and Chinese culture. The history of the enrollment of international students in Shanghai can be traced back to 1954 and the number of international students has maintained a rapid increase since 1990s. The number has rocketed by 16 times from 3388 international students in 1999 to 56027 in 2014, coming from 187 countries and regions.

In 2012, based on the "2011-2015 Action Plan of the Shanghai Educational Internationalization Project", to further enrich the cultural activities of international students studying in Shanghai and strengthen their sense of identity of Chinese culture, the Shanghai Municipal Education Commission held the first "China in My Eyes; Shanghai International Student Chinese Element Creative Design Contest" with a great success in 2013, which received active participation from international students studying in Shanghai and collected 279 works with 124 winning awards.

The second contest was launched in April of 2014 and lasted for 8 months. International students had made varied creations on the theme of "My Student Life in Shanghai". Ultimately, 24 universities selected 305 works created by international students from 58 countries to be entries of the contest. Reviewed by experts, 2 works won the Special Awards, 10 works won the 1st Prizes, 20 works won the 2nd Prizes, 31 works won the 3rd Prizes and 45 works won the Engagement Awards.

This is a collection of prizewinning works in the second contest, illustrating international students' colorful life in Shanghai. 

### Description/作品说明

This design of textile pattern and shoes is inspired by the stone on old Shanghai's Shikumen. Through years of natural weathering, the texture of the stone has absorbed the sweat of uncountable hard workers. This textile pattern is coupled with classic black and white color; gradient method is adopted with the Chinese water ink painting. It can be used in fashionable boots and pointy flat shoes. For the vamp, autumn and winter leather with striped corduroy and a unique matching pattern are selected, which give it a Shanghai style look as well as a fashionable design.

这一作品的纺织品图案设计与鞋子设计,灵感均来自老上海石库门上的石头,石头上的纹理经过多年的自然风化,累积了无数辛勤者的汗水。配以时尚经典的黑白套色,采用中国水墨画般的渐变处理方式,创作出这个纺织品图案,运用在时尚的靴子和尖头平底鞋中。鞋面选择秋冬的皮革、条纹肌理感的灯芯绒和独特的印花搭配,制造出既有上海风格又时尚的设计。
