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中国人民解放军军乐团简介

中国人民解放军军乐团隶属中国人民解放军总政治部，始创于 1947 年。1949 年作为主力乐队参加新中国开国大典，首次奏响《中华人民共和国国歌》。1952 年经毛泽东主席提议扩编成立于北京。乐团现有各类专业人员 360 人，分三支大型交响管乐队、一支管乐教学队（解放军艺术学院军乐表演专业本科班）和一个音乐创作室。

作为国家礼仪乐团，六十多年来曾为来访的近二百个国家的近千位国家元首、政府首脑和军队领导人演奏。圆满完成历次国庆大典，历届全国人大、全国政协会议，香港和澳门回归祖国交接仪式及北京奥运会、上海世博会、广州亚运会等重大活动司礼演奏任务七千余次，受到各界高度赞扬。

在担负国家和军队礼宾任务的同时，乐团作为国内唯一的国家级管乐艺术表演团体，始终以引领全国管乐艺术的发展为己任，积极探索和丰富表演形式，形成了以交响管乐为主体，行进管乐、爵士乐、流行管乐和多种形式的器乐独奏、重奏以及声乐并举的表演风格，被国内外媒体誉为“中国管乐艺术的领军团队”。

Introduction

The Military Band of the People's Liberation Army (PLA) of China was founded in 1947, subordinated to the PLA General Political Department. As the principal band, it participated in the founding ceremony of the People's Republic of China in 1949, playing the national anthem for the first time. In 1952 at the proposal of Chairman Mao Zedong, an expanded PLA Band was established in Beijing. The PLA Band now has 360 specialists divided into three symphonic bands, a teaching team (for undergraduates majoring in wind music at the PLA Academy of Arts) and a composition office.

Serving as the national ceremonial band, it has performed more than 7,000 times over the past more than 60 years for occasions such as state visits, National Day celebrations, the handover ceremonies for Hong Kong and Macao, the Beijing Olympic Games, the Shanghai Expo, and the Guangzhou Asian Games, among others.

It has always been the nation's leader in wind music development, playing a proactive role in exploring and enriching such forms as symphonic, marching, jazz and pop music. The PLA Band is hailed as China's Leading Team in Wind Music by media both at home and abroad.
