



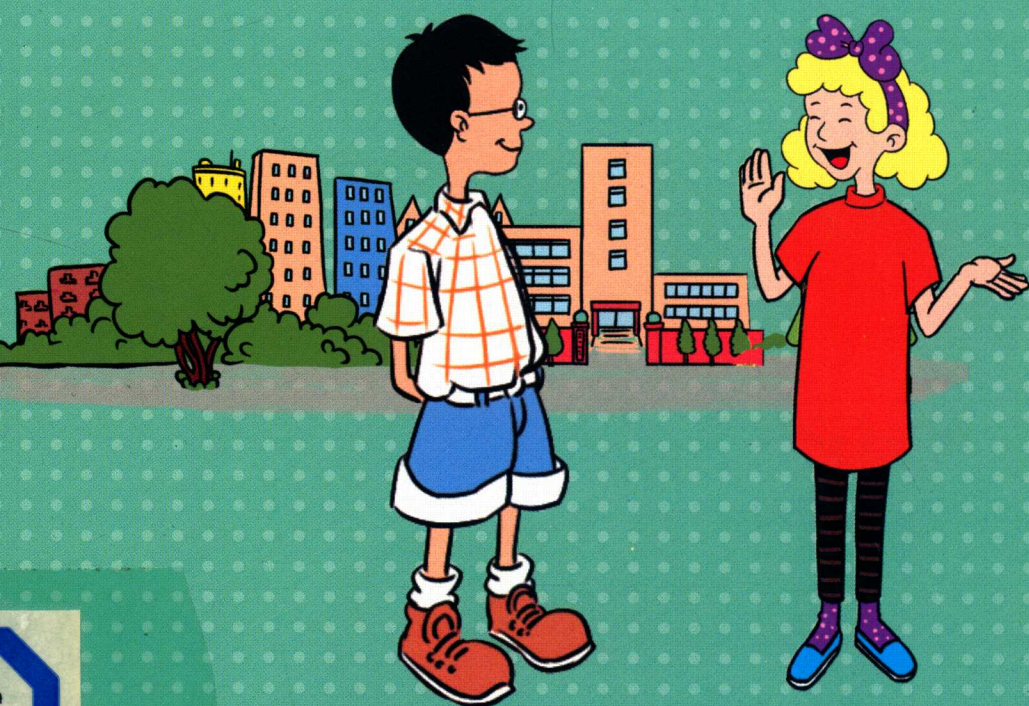

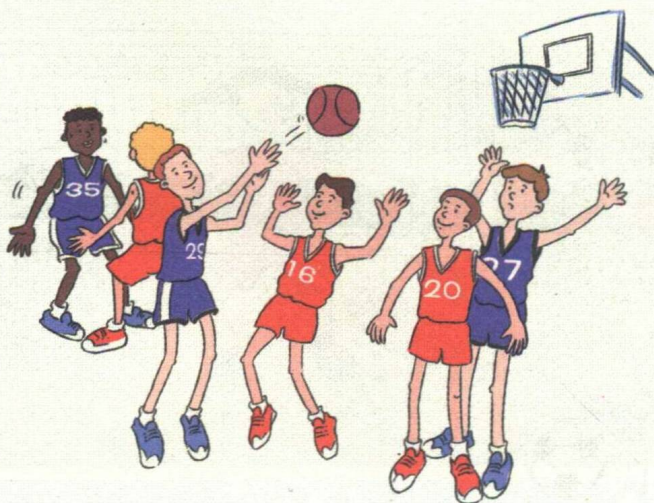

同学们，这学期你们将继续学习人称代词和一般过去时等知识，在学习中，你们要注意发现语言规律并积极主动地运用这些规律。

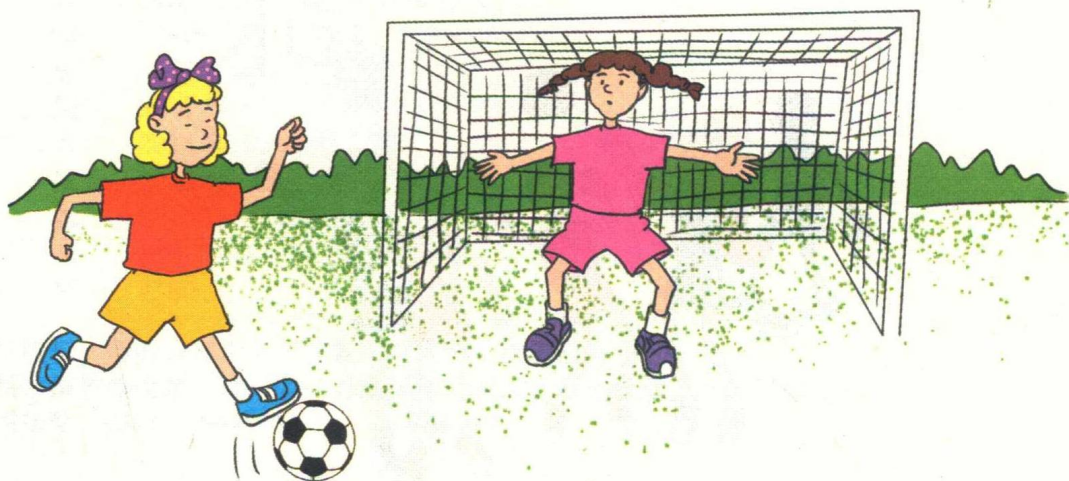

Li Ming: Good morning, Mrs. Smith. What time is it?

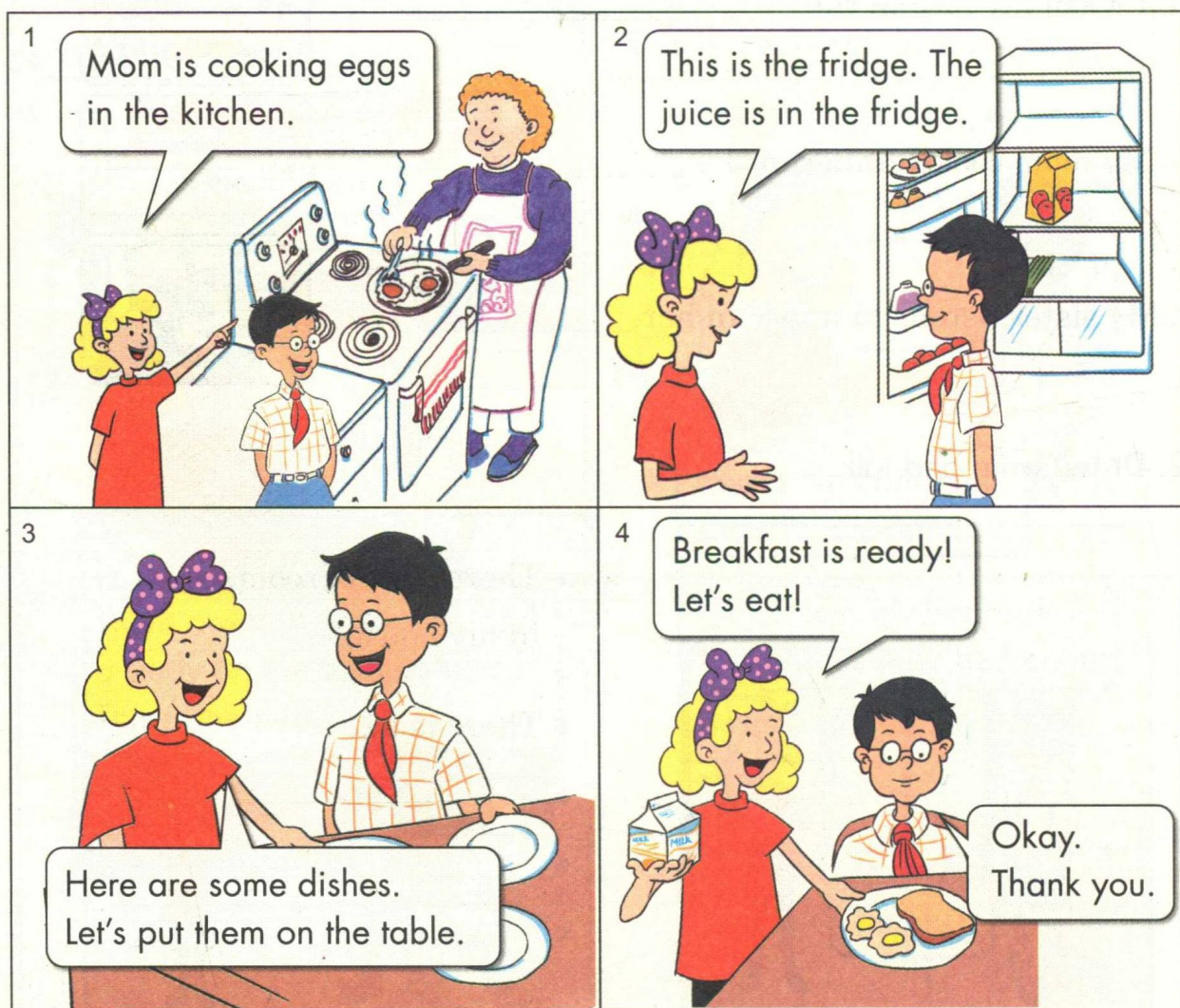
Mrs. Smith: It's half past seven. Time for breakfast!
