请你们多参与英语学习活动,经常与老师和同学交流学习体会,探索适合自己的学习方法。相信你们一定能学得更好!




## Lesson 1 At the Airport





Li Ming: Good morning, Mrs. Smith. What time is it?


Mrs. Smith: It's half past seven. Time for breakfast!

What would you like for breakfast, Li Ming?


Li Ming: I'd like some eggs, bread and juice, please.

Jenny: I'd like some milk and bread, please.









#### Story time




