

How to Study English Well?

Most students say English is very difficult to learn. But I don't think so. English is easy, if you study hard.

I listen to the teacher carefully in all of the English classes. After class, I recite the words and texts by heart, till very fluently (流利). In exams, I am very careful. But this is not all. I think learning more English can give me good marks. The best way is reading English magazines and I try to read the stories in English whenever I can. If I see a new word, I'll look it up in the dictionary. But the first time, I can't remember it. So I try to look up the word twice, three times, till I remember the word very well. I often ask others if I have questions. I don't only learn rules of grammar (清法规则), I think doing more speaking and more listening is good for me, so I often listen to the radio and watch the English programmes on TV.

"Person is very easy to be proud" (人是最容易骄傲的). After succeeding (成功) or getting good marks in an exam, I will be a little proud. I've failed in an exam, because I was too proud. After that, if I am proud, I'll say to myself," You're really nobody!"

If you want to study English well, you must remember: Try your best to do more reading, more writing, more listening and more speaking whenever you can Don't forget: Always be modest (永远谦虚).
