## 内 容 提 要

本书针对中国学生在学用英语相似词语时遇到的困难，选编了 234 对（组）常见而又易于混淆的相似词语，进行比较和辨析，涉及的词、词组或短语达 585 个之多。各对（组）相似词语的比较和辨析，突出了重点和疑难点，说明性文字简明、扼要，并配备了说服力较强的英文例证及中文译文，还安排了少而精的填空练习，书后附有练习答案和词语查阅索引。

本书可供大、中学生和英语自学者学习英语相似词语时使用，也可以作为一般英语语言工作者的参考用书。

## 序

我有好些中青年同事和朋友，林裕音老师是其中之一。在日常接触中，我觉得这人不平凡——是个教学迷，又潜心搞科研。因为喜欢这种爱啃硬骨头的性格，所以在她要我为她和冯启忠老师合著的《英语相似词语辨析》写几句话时，我便欣然应命。

我认为，一本英语教学参考书如想受到欢迎，首先要有两个性：一是可信性，二是实用性。在这两方面，这本书都有值得称道之处。

谈到可信性，我高兴地看到作者已采取了必要的措施：①书中例证都来自英美权威著作，并且经过再三核对；②许多问题两位作者都研究讨论过；③初稿写成之后，还请王应龙教授细心审校过部分稿件。

关于实用性，自然要留待读者来评判，但是我可以摆出一些供参考的第一手材料。近几个月来，在为一些别的朋友看稿过程中，我曾经碰到几个不大不小的问题，煞费周章。真没想到，当我正在苦思冥想之际，作者已在书中提出这些问题，并且以与我殊途同归的办法把它解决了。

这三个问题是：

1. 有一位同事这样写：Tariffs and drawbacks greatly effect import and export business. 他的意思是，海关税率和退税对进出口业大有影响。

我对作者说，“你把 effect 作为动词，表示产生某种影响。请你看看 *The Concise Oxford Dictionary* 的释义是否与你的相符。”

COD 是这样说的：

effect—v. ① bring about, accomplish (这不等于产生影响)  
② cause to exist or occur (这也不等于产生影响)

看了这些释义，作者醒悟了，他把 effect 改为 affect。

2. 有一位同事这样写：This plan is unsatisfactory in many aspects. 我说，“这句话是通顺的，不过请你考虑一下，是说 in many aspects 好呢，还是说 in many respects 好呢？”

他查了几本词典，发现了好些关于 respect 的实例：

- a. correct except in this respect (COD)
- b. In many respects (=in many ways) the new film is better than the original. (*Cambridge International Dictionary of English*)
- c. a good plan in many respects (*Merriam Webster's Collegiate Dictionary*)
- d. In many respects Asian women see themselves as equal to their men. (*Collins Cobuild English Dictionary*)

至于 in many aspects 呢，他可一个例子也找不到。经过了一番思考，他决定用 in many respects。

3. 有一位研究生这样写：He is a competent student. 我说，“我只见过 a competent teacher, a competent driver, a competent critic, 可没见过 a competent student, a competent passenger, a competent browser，这里边料想有点道理。你是否要琢磨琢磨？”

他琢磨了好一会儿，还查了 *Kenkusha's Dictionary Of English Collocations*。出乎意料，他发现了这么一条：a competent student of contemporary politics.

他问，“competent 跟 student 连用，这儿不是早有先例吗？”

我的回答是：“请你注意，在这一条里边，非但有 a competent student，后面还有 of contemporary politics。competent 这个定语的出现，是以 of contemporary politics 为条件的。”

翻读林与冯合著的书稿，一个感想油然而生：先前要是有这本书，我就可以少费许多唇舌了。

有不少英语教师是不想多费唇舌的，我向他们推荐这本书。有不少研究生和本科生也希望尽量自己解决疑难问题，不用找老师，我同样向他们推荐这本书。

## 前　　言

英语是拼音文字，有不少拼写、语音形式相近似或者词汇、语法意义相近似的词语。它们有的形、音不同，但词义和用法相似；有的形、音相似，但意义迥异；有的则概念相同，词义近似，但含义不同，甚至大相径庭。因此，缘文生义，不求甚解，是误用相似词语的一个重要原因。

为了帮助中国学生析疑、解惑、用词恰当，我们在本书中辑录了 234 对（组）常用而又易于混淆的相似词语进行比较和辨析，涉及的词、词组或短语达 585 个之多。我们知道，每一个词都有一定的拼写形式、语音形式、词汇意义和语法意义，词本身又是这几个特征的统一体。要把问题说得透彻，可比较和辨析的方面颇多。基于甄烦就简、突出重点和疑难点的原则，我们不全面开花，而是有针对性、有选择性地比较拼写、语音形式上的差异，比较语义上的差异，比较语体或感情色彩上的差异，比较词的搭配和位置分布上的差异。通过比较，帮助读者消除疑惑，提高辨析技能，并希望大家通过反复实践，最终学会正确使用相似词语，这是我们编著此书的初衷。为此，我们在比较、辨析各对或各组相似词语的时候，不但注意做到诠释简明、扼要，提供说服力较强的例证，还在其后配备了少而精的辨异填空练习（参考答案附书后），让读者在掌握了辨析的指引后，趁热打铁，马上实践一下，以达到学以致用的目的。为了方便读者查阅，我们还在书后编辑了词语索引。

我们在编著本书时，参考了国内外出版的许多辞典和有关词汇学、语义学、语法学方面的书籍（详见书后“主要参考书”）。
