Introduction

R D Blackmore

Richard Doddridge Blackmore was born in 1825, the son of a Church of England priest. He went to school in Tiverton, which is where we meet John Ridd in the first chapter of this book.

Blackmore went to Exeter College, Oxford, and then studied law. He practised as a lawyer in the courts for a few years, but poor health forced him to leave London, and he started growing flowers, fruit and vegetables for the market. At the same time, he wrote poetry, not very successfully. His first novel, Clara Vaughan, was much more successful when it appeared in 1864.

His historical novel *Lorna Doone* appeared in 1869. It was not a great success when it first came out in three volumes. Some people liked the way the hero, John Ridd, was presented on his Exmoor farm, the way his love of the country became clear. They spoke to others about the book, its exciting adventures and its tender love story, and so more people read it. It became a classic, although neither the writer nor the booksellers expected it. And it is still a well-loved classic, often used today as material for films and television.

It was partly an accident that the novel became a "bestseller". A young member of the company which had produced

Introduction

Frances Hodgson Burnett

Frances Hodgson was born in Manchester, England, in 1849. Her father was successful as a **dealer** in metal goods, but he died while Frances was still very young. The family continued to **deal** in metal goods, but more and more of their trade was with the southern states of America. The American Civil War, between the northern states and some southern states (1861—65), ended badly for the southern states and for the Hodgson company. The Hodgsons went to the United States and lived in the state of Tennessee.

They were very poor until Frances had some success as a writer from 1866, when she was seventeen years old.

In 1873, Frances Hodgson married Dr Swan Burnett. Her name was already known to many readers, so Mrs Frances Burnett kept the "Hodgson" in her name as a writer.

She had great success with her novel Little Lord Fauntleroy in 1886. Learned people now think that this story of an American boy who becomes an English lord is not good because it plays too much on the reader's feelings. But thousands of people enjoyed it.

The Secret Garden came out in 1909. It was written for children, but older people enjoy it because it shows the writer's surprising understanding of children, even when she herself was sixty years old.

Frances Hodgson Burnett died in 1924 in Long Island, USA.

The Secret Garden

The story begins in India at a time when very many British people lived there. They worked in **government**, in the army, on the railways and in trade. They were not all like the father and mother of Mary in this story, but many of them had plenty of Indian servants, and sometimes the European mothers did not give enough time and care to their own children. The hot season was not good for Europeans, and there were illnesses that the doctors did not know much about. That is how Mary became an **unhealthy**, rather **nasty** child.

England would seem a strange country after the India that Mary knew. And the Yorkshire **moors** would be even stranger. They are cold in winter. The wind blows strongly over them, with very few trees to stop it. You don't see many houses on the high moors, and the rough grass is all right for sheep but not for cows or other farm animals. The Yorkshire people believe it is very healthy, but an unhappy little child from India wouldn't think so at first.
