

前言

《适应性词汇语法练习》是在努力使大学英语教学质量再上一个台阶和深入开展面向二十一世纪教学改革研究的形势下编写的。旨在精讲多练、打下扎实的语言基础,真正提高学生的语言实际运用能力。

词汇练习部分共分 12 个单元。每个单元包括多项选择,填空、汉译英和英译汉等四部分。练习中突出同义词、近义词的辨析、词组和固定搭配的用法及翻译技巧。以确保读者掌握词义,并能正确、熟练地使用。

语法练习部分分语法单项练习与注释;语法综合练习自测题;综合完形填空与注释三个部分。练习题是在统计并分析了历次四级曝光题、大量的四级模拟题以及考研试题的基础上编写而成的,并增设了大量主观题型练习,练习形式多样化。目的是为了给学生打下扎实的语法基础。

词汇练习部分是吴衍莉副教授组织编写的。1—4 单元由吴衍莉编写; 5—8 单元由李京平编写; 9—12 单元由周红红编写。语法练习的 1—6 项的练习与注释由王薇副教授编写; 7—16 项的练习与注释以及第二部分的语法综合练习自测题由蒋学清编写; 第三部分综合完形填空与注释由马玉玲编写。编者的排序按本书编写顺序排列。全书由冀成会教授审定。
