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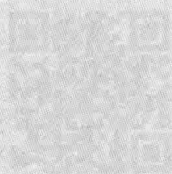

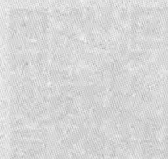

从在整个试卷所占的分值比例来看，阅读理解无疑是考研英语的重点内容。阅读理解分为A、B两个部分，共25题，每小题分值2分，共计50分，占整个考试分值的一半。其中阅读理解A部分占40分，是阅读中的重中之重。阅读理解A部分共四篇文章，篇幅长度大约为1500词，每篇文章后面设有5个问题，共20题，每小题2分。

【考研阅读理解的解题思路】

1. 以自然段为单位，阅读原文，读一段解一题。
2. 精确审题，标记出题干的考查范围、涉及对象。
3. 返回原文，再次精读，比对选项得出答案。
4. 如果遇到生词或理解障碍，则通过连词、特殊标点及上下文之间的逻辑关系等避开难点。
5. 实在无法确定选项时，可先不做任何选择，等通读原文后再做决定（遵循“先易后难”原则）。
6. 最后，利用正确答案的特征、错误答案的特征选出正确答案。

解题技巧

1. 文章的主旨往往在首段转折后或开篇设问中。

2. 概括文章中心可以将各个自然段的段意连成一个完整的意思，这个意思即文章的中心。

3. 对于给文章选择最佳标题的主旨题，应采用“逆向思维法”：以备选项为题目去构思一篇文章，看构思的文章是否符合原文的内容和结构。注意：给文章选标题时不需要吸引读者，只要求完全概括原文，拒绝标题党，拒绝文艺范。

4. 尤其要注意 BPES (background 背景、problem 问题、explanation 说明、solution 解决方案) 文章，其中心往往不在第一部分 (背景)，而是出现在第二部分 (问题)。如果看见首段为记叙文体的文章，则其主旨往往在后面说明议论的部分。

5. 错误选项往往是用局部信息 (段意) 代替全文中心，或是扩大范围。

2. 要注意的是考查宏观态度还是考查微观态度。解题时一定要标记出题干中态度题考查的范围，即态度的发出者和态度承受者，切不可“跟着感觉走”。
3. 除了要注意常规的表达态度方向的动词、形容词、副词之外，还要特别注意语气词在态度方向题中的作用。
4. 不要把自己的态度揉入其中，还要区分作者的态度是否和其引用的“专家”态度完全一致。（注意：如果作者态度和“专家”态度不一致，则为常考点。）
5. 态度题中，表示否定、质疑等消极方向的词成为正确选项的可能性较高。

4. 答案往往不出现于生词所在的句子中，而是出现在距离这个句子最近的上一句或下一句中。
5. 干扰选项往往脱离原文语境，只取生词的字面含义或第一释义。
