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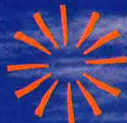
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关于本书

阅读中

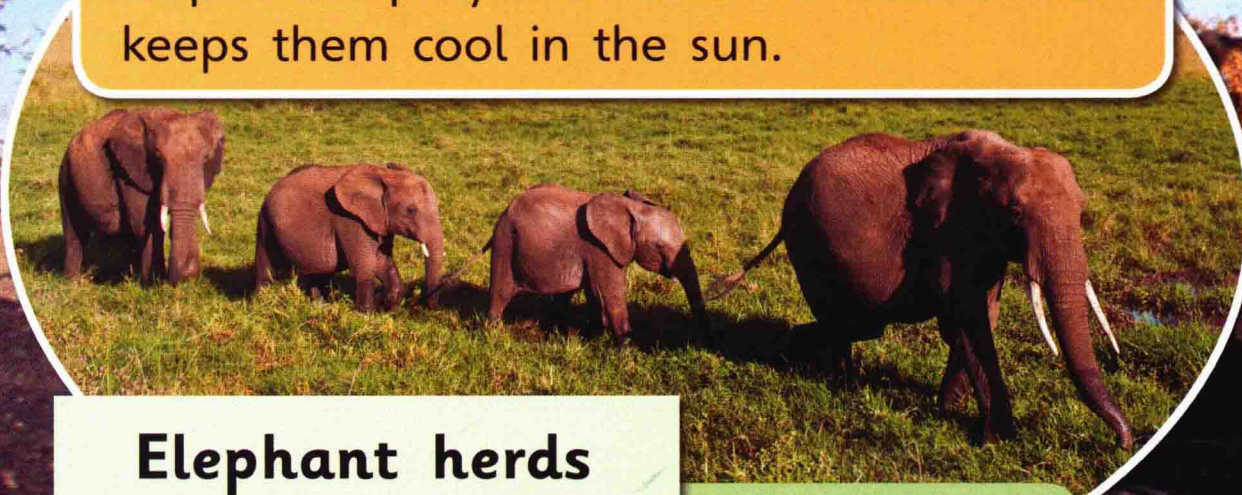


An Elephant

Elephants spray their skin with mud. This keeps them cool in the sun.



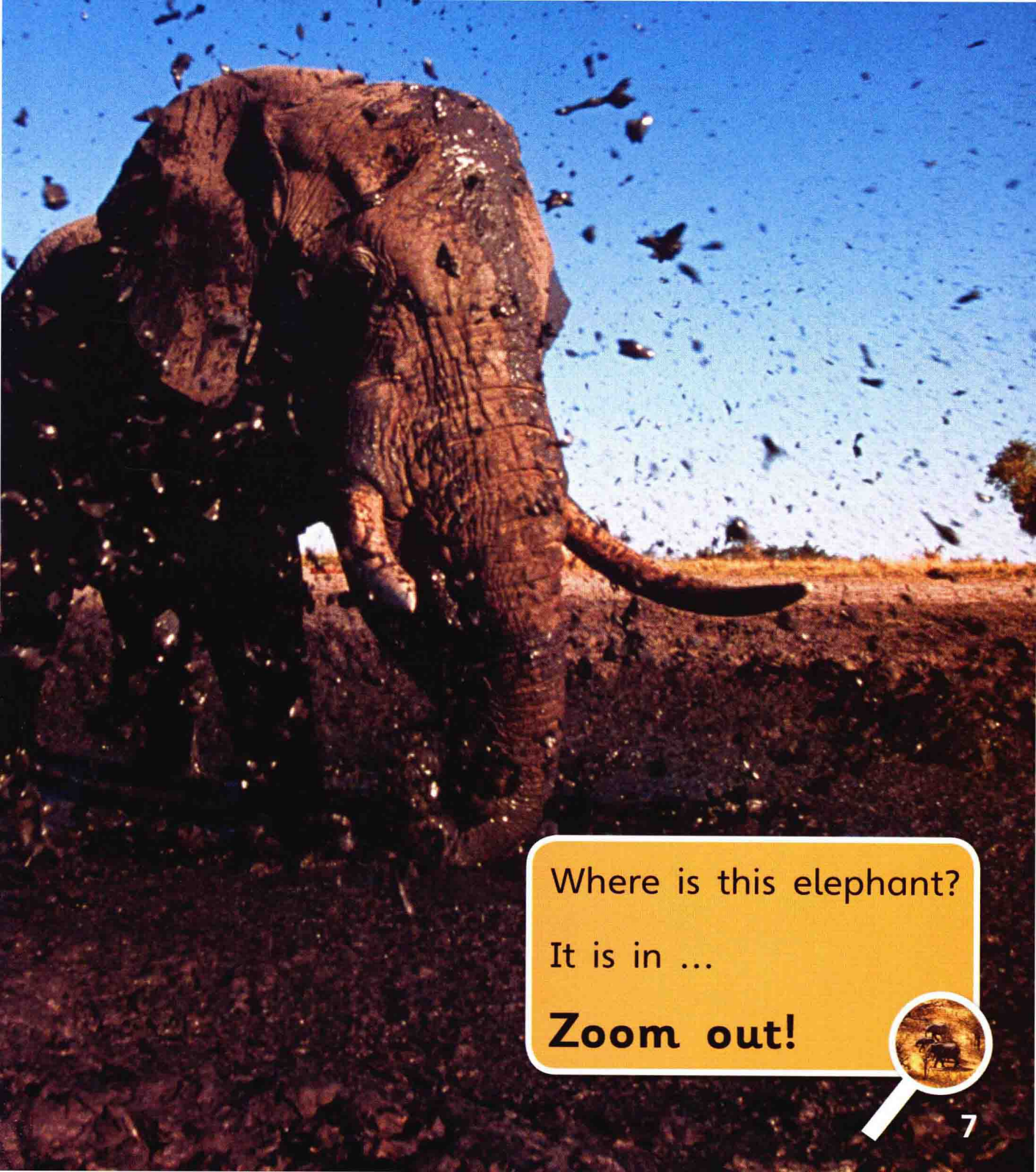
Elephant herds

Kenya also has more than one thousand types of bird.

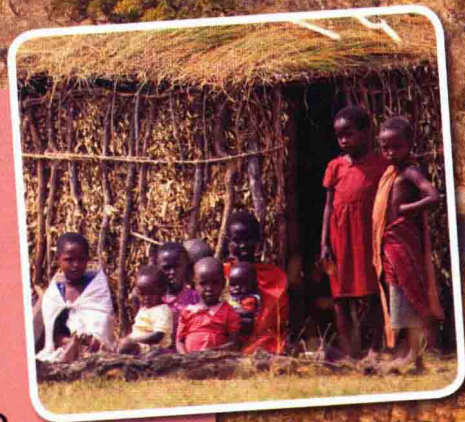


Kenyan people

Some Kenyan people live in big, busy cities. Others, like the **Masai** people, live on the **plains**.

- ▶ Masai: a group of people who live in Kenya and Tanzania
- ▶ plains: large areas of flat countryside with few trees

Africa

- ▶ **continent**: a huge area of land that can include many different countries
- ▶ **deserts**: areas of land with very little rainfall and few plants
- ▶ **billion**: one thousand million (1 000 000 000)
