

如何科学有效地突破英语专业考试大纲规定的 13000 词大关,是很多专八考 生迫切想要解决的问题。《专八词汇》应运而生,特色如下:

1. 科学收词,高效助考

英语专业教学大纲规定的词汇量为 13000 词,其中高年级词汇约 5000 词。本书精选了专八考试中约 3000 个重点单词及其派生词,约 2000 个认知词汇,精心梳理了 700 多个最常考专四词回顾。旨在帮助考生在紧张有限的备考时间里,有针对性地记住难词、生词和重点词。考生在学完本书之后,词汇量有望突破 13000 词大关。

2. 乱序串记单词,有规律更好记

记单词好比摘葡萄,一串串记明显要比一个个孤立地记更规律好记。本书通过 科学分析和总结,将不同字母开头的单词按同根、近义、反义等关系归类串联起来, 考生在学习的时候,不仅可学到某一单词的相关释义及用法,同时可将该词的近义 词反义词等一网打尽,达到极佳的学习效果。

3. 分频记忆,优先记住重点单词

本书通过科学编排,将单词按考查频率、难易程度及重要性区分为三个重要程度不同的部分,分别是最常考词汇、核心词汇和认知词汇,单词的轻重缓急一目了然。考生优先记住最重要的单词,避免平均用力,可迅速提高学习效率,随时都能参加考试。

此外,本书在专四专八直通词汇部分巧妙精选了 200 多个能衍生出专八考词的 专四词.帮助考生利用已掌握的专四词,快速贯通专八词。

4. 英文释义,准确理解词义,辨别易混词

由于英语和汉语的差异,英语词汇与其汉语释义的内涵和外延往往不是完全对等的,这就造成很多时候需要结合英文释义才能更准确地理解词义,辨别易混词。有鉴于此,本书的重点单词不仅配有记忆方法、例句、用法、词源、辨析等详细内容外,还配有来自权威词典的英文释义。


