

自序

承德,旧称热河。位于河北省东北部,是首批国家历史文化名城。这里山岭起伏、地势高峻,是华北地区森林覆盖率最高的城市,被称为"华北之肺"。夏季凉爽,雨量集中,是我国著名的避暑胜地。清代康熙、乾隆年间,在这里修建了避暑山庄和外八庙,雄伟的古建筑群和园林景观,把这座城市装点得更加绮丽多姿。这些古建筑和园林承载着整个承德的历史与文化。为此,我一直希望能通过手中的钢笔将这些古建筑与园林进行呈现。自2013年起,我先后多次前往承德市、滦平县、隆化县、围场县等地进行写生和采风,并对古建筑、园林、村落、文化遗址、民俗等进行实地考察与调研,特别是对避暑山庄与外八庙的深入考察,使我对承德有了更深入的认识。

我将本书分为三个部分,分别是避暑山庄、外八庙和其他古建筑,避暑山庄和外八庙在本书中所 占篇幅近 90%。

一、避暑山庄

避暑山庄又名"热河行官""承德离官",位于承德市区北部。始建于清康熙四十二年(1703年),历经清康熙、雍正、乾隆三朝,耗时89年建成。为世界最大的皇家园林,与北京颐和园、苏州拙政园和留园并称为中国四大名园。1994年,避暑山庄及周围寺庙被联合国教科文组织遗产委员会列入《世界遗产名录》。避暑山庄盛景众多,建筑布局大体可分为官殿区和苑景区两大部分,而苑景区又分为平原区、湖泊区、山峦区。园内有楼、台、亭、阁、殿、寺、观、庵等景观120余处,著名的景观有康熙三十六景、乾隆三十六景以及烟雨楼、文园狮子林等。为此,在本书中我未按地理区位对这些景致进行排序,而是从历史文化的角度按照康熙三十六景在前,乾隆三十六景在中,之后为其他建筑的方式进行排列。

二、外八庙

清初,喇嘛教在我国西藏、蒙古等少数民族聚居地区占有支配地位。清政府为团结西藏、蒙古等地区的少数民族,加强对边疆地区的管理,利用宗教作为手段,在避暑山庄外围先后修建了 12 座寺庙,即溥仁寺、溥善寺、普宁寺、普佑寺、安远庙、普乐寺、普陀宗乘之庙、广安寺、殊像寺、罗汉堂、须弥福寿之庙和广缘寺。其中溥仁寺、普宁寺等八座寺庙由朝廷派驻喇嘛,隶属于清廷直属的理藩院管理,又都在长城古北口外,因此一般称为"外八庙",并成为这 12 座寺庙的代名词。事实上,外八庙中所有的寺庙都是基于民族团结而修建的。因溥善寺、广安寺等寺庙如今仅存遗址,我在本书的完成过程中,只对"外八庙"中的九座寺庙进行了实地考察和采风,故本书也仅收录了九所寺庙。

三、其他古建筑

因避暑山庄的存在,承德在清代成为夏都,是当时仅次于北京的另一重要政治中心,有塞外京都之称。因此除避暑山庄与外八庙,还兴建了大批府邸、寺庙和行宫。仅承德市区就有热河都统署、肃顺府、文庙、关帝庙、城隍庙、火神庙、清真寺及多个牌楼,周边县市还有清代皇家的行宫、猎场等场所。为呈现一个更丰富、更完整的承德,我将这些古迹列入本书。

在本书完成之际,首先要感谢学苑出版社周鼎编辑的信任,是他为我提供了编写出版的机会,得以让这些画作面世。我的家人、朋友与学生也给予我很多帮助与支持,在此一并表示感谢。

Preface

Called Rehe in the past, it is located in the northeast of Hebei Province and is among the first group of Famous Cites of History and Culture in China. It is a famous resort for its cool summers during which there is plenty of rain. It is referred to as the "lung" of North China. During the reign of Qing Emperors Kangxi(1662–1723) and Qianlong(1736–1796), an imperial summer resort and eight nearby temples were built here. This grand and antique building complex and parks reflect the history and culture of Chengde.

This book is divided into three parts: Royal Summer Resort, Eight Nearby Temples and Other Antique Buildings.

Part One Imperial Summer Resort

Also known as Rehe Temporary Imperial Palace or Chengde Detached Palace, the royal summer resort was built in 1703 north to Chengde City. It took 89 years to complete this largest royal garden, which experienced the reigns of three emperors: Kangxi(1662–1722), Yongzheng (1723–1735), and Qianlong(1736–1796). Together with the Summer Palace in Beijing, the Humble Administrator's Garden and Lingering Garden in Suzhou, it was one of the best four gardens in China. In 1994, this resort and the surrounding temples were included into the World Heritage List by UNESCO World Heritage Committee. The resort is famous for many beautiful sites in the palace and garden sections. The latter is composed of flat regions, lakes, mountains with more than 120 scenes, including buildings, stages, pavilions, halls, Buddhist and Taoist temples, etc. Among them, there are 36 scenes with Emperor Kangxi's Inscriptions, 36 scenes with of Emperor Qianlong's inscriptions and Misty Rain Building, Lion Grove Garden of Wenyuan, etc.

Part Two Eight Surrounding Temples

In the early Qing Dynasty (1644–1911), Lamaism was predominant in the area where Tibetan and Mongolian ethnic minorities lived. So the government united these religious minorities to strengthen the security of the border areas. Thus, at the periphery of the resort, the government built twelve temples at one time or another, including Puren, Pushan, Puning, Puyou, Anyuan, Pule, Putuozongsheng, Guang'an, Zhuxiang, Luohan, Xumifushou and Guangyuan Temples. Among them, eight including Puren and Puning Temples were home to Lamas sent by the royal

court, and were under the direct administration of the Court of Colonial Affairs. Also, because of their location north to the Great Wallin Gukoubei Town, they are commonly called the "eight surrounding temples" all of which were built for national solidarity.

Part Three Other Antique Buildings

Because of the imperial resort, Chengde was called the Summer Capital in the Qing Dynasty and was an important political center second only to Beijing. It also got a nickname of the "Capital beyond the Great Wall". Therefore, besides the resort and the eight surrounding temples, a large number of mansions, temples and palaces were constructed. Chengde City alone, there are Rehe Commander-in-chief Administration, Su Shun's Mansion, Confucian Temple, Guanyu Temple, town god temples, fire god temples, mosques and many memorial archways. In the counties and cities, there are temporary royal palaces and hunting grounds, etc.

Upon the completion of this book, first of all, I would like to thank Mr. Zhou Ding of the Academy Press for his trust. Without him, I would not have the opportunity to compile and publish this book and, of course, the readers no chance of reading it. During the writing process, my family, friends and students gave me their support, for which I express my appreciation.


