前　　言

在英语高考、大学英语三、四级统考和“托福”考试中，英文短文写作是测试应试者英语书面表达能力的关键题。由于时间有限，字数要求严格，并要求正确表达思想，意思连贯，无重大语法错误，对此多数考生甚感困难。因此，英文短文写作是难度大、失分多的一项。实践证明问题的症结在于多数考生没有经过写作的系统和严格训练。我们编写此书的目的就是使考生在较短时间内掌握写作的基础知识和写作技巧，以期尽快提高写作水平和增强应试能力，取得优异成绩。

本书按描写文、记叙文、说明文、议论文及书信体裁的顺序安排，并提供简明扼要的基础理论知识和大量各种题材的范文。范文文字浅显，通顺流畅；结构严谨；内容清新，覆盖面宽，涉及领域极其广泛，其中包括学校及学校生活、家庭、教育、友谊、读书与知识、道德与修养、择业及未来、健康与运动、成功与快乐、习惯与消遣等现代生活的各个方面。读过此书，读者会自然悟出英文短文写作之奥妙，并为今后提高写作水平打下基础。

本书实用性和针对性强，是广大中学生、大学生和英语学习者的必备参考书。

序

英文短文写作是运用语言能力和写作基础知识的活动。

应试者在 20—30 分钟内根据所给的情景和要求(所写材料的目的、对象、内容、长度等)写一篇 100 字左右的短文。短文内容包括日常生活、人物、故事、事件和一般外事交往等;体裁包括描写文、记叙文、说明文和议论文,还有书信。

书面表达要求:

切题——一定按所给的情景和要求写,切记扣住主题。主题叙述清楚,思想表达完整,选材恰当,观点正确。

组织结构——文章层次分明、段落清楚、扩展合理,论证、说明或分析充分,启、承、转自然,做到内容和结构连贯。

文理通顺——语言准确规范、清晰易懂,选词准确,表达无误。避免歧义或冗词赘句。

布局合理——注意各种体裁文章的格式,正确使用标点符号,字迹工整和规范。

文章体裁一般可分四种:描写文、记叙文、说明文和论说文。这四种体裁相互间既有区别又有联系,有的文章的目的比较单一,内容比较简单,从头至尾采取一种写作方式,但大多数文章由于表达思想内容比较复杂,在写作方式上通常以一种为主,也兼有其他几种方式加以配合。本书的目的就在于使读者能够掌握这四种文体的写作,并在实践中加以应用。

1. A SNOWY WINTER NIGHT
