的首都及名胜吗？那就开始我们这学期的学习吧！

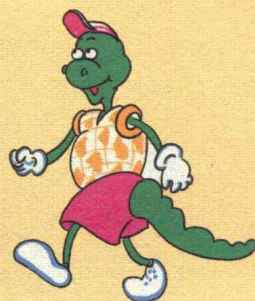

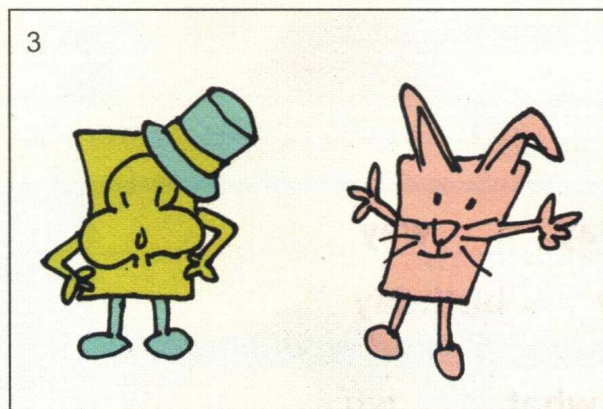
## Story time



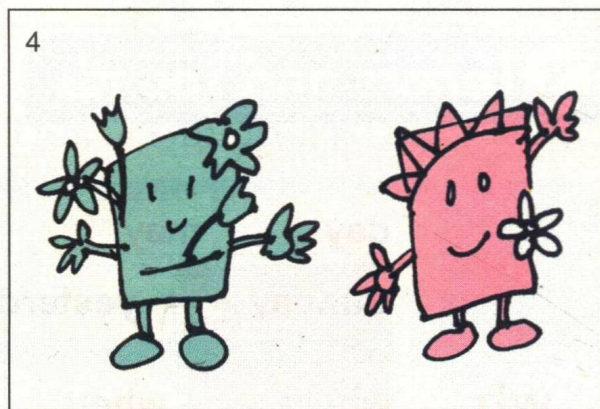
A long time ago, Mr. Moon did not have a birthday. He wanted to find a month for his birthday.
