
遵循科学的学习方法,完美体现语言学习过程中的黄金规律。



本套教材严格遵守欧洲共同语言参考标准(CEFR),全套共6种颜色(赤、橙、黄、绿、蓝、紫)分别对应语言学习的6个阶段(入门级、初级、中级、中高级、高级、专家级)。根据每一阶段(除专家级外)学习者的英语运用能力,又分为由浅到深的3个小级别,每完成3个级别可实现进阶,总共是16级。
