编者的话

在英语学习过程中，读与听是输入的重要途径，而说与写则是输出的重要渠道。读与听是理解的技能，说与写是表达的技能。输入多了，则有助于输出，它们在语言学习与交流中相辅相成，相互促进。所以“听”是掌握一门外语的重要环节之一。

我们编写了这套听力丛书《听力赛跑》，分为（预备篇）、（接力篇）和（冲刺篇），在选材上涉及日常生活、人文风貌、自然科学，时代气息浓郁，贴近实际生活，突出交际性和实用性；在音带的语速上采取了由慢速渐进到与高考同步的速度。具有了层次性，稳步推进，螺旋上升，阶梯跃进，为进入高中学习的学生不断取得进步而树立必胜信心和享受学习乐趣，为他们顺利进入高等学府助一臂之力。

在听的过程中，要养成好的习惯。

*听前预测。在听录音前，先阅读所给的文字材料、答案选项等，思考一下：题干本身提供哪些信息；题目可以引起哪些联想；说话者的意图是什么，从中可发现一些怎样的背景信息。预测了短文或对话可能涉及到的内容，这样听录音材料时就能有的放矢，有所侧重，提高答题的准确率。

*学会用英语思维。听的时候避免将每个单词和句子翻译成汉语，否则既浪费时间、影响思维，还会影响后面的听力理解。最好的方法是逐步培养用英语思维的能力，把语言与实物、实境对应起来，将其意象描绘在大脑中，这样不但可以节约时间，还可以提高理解力。

*养成边听录音边记录的习惯。尽量把当前任务所需要的相关重要信息（如：表示时间、日期、年龄、价格和距离等的数字或地名和所属关系等关键信息词）快速记录下来，不同的人名或地名可用不同的首字母替代；不同的方位、顺序关系或主要内容可用不同的符号或图形表示；以便使所听内容更加条理分明。

*注意听短文的首句、首段。文章的开首句和开首段，往往是对短文内容的概括，如：讲话的目的，主要的内容，作者的论点，故事发生的时间、地点及事物等。

*打好扎实的语言基本功。熟练掌握语音、语调、词汇、语法是做好听力题的关键。其中语法主要考察：时态语态、虚拟语气、比较等级、不定式等。

听力理解不像阅读理解，它是单向的，一次性的，如果我们的识别速度跟不上放音速度，就会顾此失彼，非常被动。所以要通过一定数量的听力训练，促使学生在“听”的过程中综合运用学过的英语知识，使大脑产生积极的思维，同时不断训练听觉，培养语感，养成听英语的习惯，提高听力水平。

希望我们的这套丛书能对你有所帮助。
