In certain occupations color blindness can be dangerous and candidates are tested most

carefully. For example, when fighting at night, soldiers use light of flares to signal each other. A green light may mean "Advance" and a red light may mean "Danger! Keep back!" You can see what will happen if somebody thinks that red is green! Color blindness in human beings is a strange thing to explain. In a single eye there are millions of very small things called "cones" (锥状细胞). These help to see in a bright light and to tell the difference between colors. There are also millions of "rods" (视杆细胞) but these are used for seeing when it is nearly dark. They show us shape, but not color. Wait until it is dark tonight, then go outside. Look round you and try to see what colors you can recognize.

Birds and animals which hunt at night have eyes which contain few or no cones at all, so they cannot see colors. As far as we know, bats and adult owls cannot see colors at all; they see only light and dark shapes. Similarly, cats and dogs cannot see colors as well as we can.
