

前言

一一 语语法和词汇选择题是历年高考题型中的重要项目,它 涉及语法及词汇运用各方面的知识,并能验证学生掌握 的熟练程度,因此一直受到广大师生的高度重视。临近高考 阶段,学生们都不惜投入大量精力和时间对此项目进行训练。 要想在此部分获得高分,就需勤练多练,然而盲目大量地做 题只会无谓地消耗学生的精力 为帮助高三学生和教师在最 后的复习阶段有的放矢地进行复习和指导,本书编者精心编 写了这本《全新高考英语语法、词汇模拟卷》。

本书围绕现行高中教材,紧扣高考大纲要求编写,共收入了25个单元2500道全真语法及词汇选择题,都是从上海及全国最新英语高考卷和模拟试卷的语法、词汇题目中精挑汇编而成的。本书针对此部分的题型特点以及经常考察的知识要点,几乎包括了全部高中阶段重要语法、词汇考点,并加强了语言的交际功能,突出了动词的灵活运用和相似词汇的横向比较。书后还附有全部答案和对重点难点题的必要解释,因此针对性、典型性更为突出。

本书的每套练习都由长期奋战在高三第一线的资深教师编写,同时听取了诸多重点教师的意见并经过专家组的最后审定,因此具有较高的权威性和可信度。高考题目虽然年年会变,但语法和词汇的知识要点却万变不离其宗,因此在关键阶段找到一本针对性强、涵盖面广、模拟性高的书来做,却是十分必要和迫切的。编者希望学生通过做这本书的精选题,核对答案,记住要领,反复推敲并钻研知识要点,定能在该项目取得高分,助你在成功之路上更上一个台阶。
