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前言

英语语法和词汇选择题是历年高考题型中的重要项目，它涉及语法及词汇运用各方面的知识，并能验证学生掌握的熟练程度，因此一直受到广大师生的高度重视。临近高考阶段，学生们都不惜投入大量精力和时间对此项目进行训练。要想在此部分获得高分，就需勤练多练，然而盲目大量地做题只会无谓地消耗学生的精力。为帮助高三学生和教师在最后的复习阶段有的放矢地进行复习和指导，本书编者精心编写了这本《全新高考英语语法、词汇模拟卷》。

本书围绕现行高中教材，紧扣高考大纲要求编写，共收入了25个单元2500道全真语法及词汇选择题，都是从上海及全国最新英语高考卷和模拟试卷的语法、词汇题目中精挑细选编而成的。本书针对此部分的题型特点以及经常考察的知识要点，几乎包括了全部高中阶段重要语法、词汇考点，并加强了语言的交际功能，突出了动词的灵活运用和相似词汇的横向比较。书后还附有全部答案和对重点难点题的必要解释，因此针对性、典型性更为突出。
