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## 前　　言

英语是一种具有极其丰富的同义词的语言，而同义词从意思上看来表面上区别不大，有些甚至可以相互代替。但从严格的意义上来说，这些所谓的同义词，实为近义词。在英语中绝对的同义词甚少，多数是意义上近似，而各自又具有特定的内涵和用法。这些差异往往极为微妙，同时也较复杂纷繁，从而使语言更加绚丽多彩。英语同义词是学习英语词汇的难点之一，不易学好，更难用好。因此，该类辞书是学习英语者必备的工具书之一。

本手册是为中国人学习和使用英语同义词而编写的。它具有如下所述的几个特点：

1. 容量大。它收编英语同义词 3000 多词条，是国内已出版的英语同义词辞书中，堪称收词最多的之一，能满足从事英语翻译、写作、应试、教学和自修的人的需要。

2. 针对性强。本手册的选词及辨析等都特别顾及中国人学习英语的特有困难，将我国学习英语者容易混淆和用错的词也收列其中，加以对比并讲解说明。本书的写作宗旨是学用结合，以用为主。本书有助于提高广大读者的英语口语能力、笔语翻译能力及写作能力，帮助读者准确、灵活调遣使用英语词汇，使读者对英语语言的应用更加流畅、生动、活泼和

有趣。

3. 解说详尽，用例丰富，编排合理。本手册比较详细地讲解英语同义词在概念意义上的异同及它们在关联意义和结构搭配上的特点等。除了文字上的辨析外，每一同义词条下都举有适量的用例，使读者通过这些例句进一步领会和掌握它们之间的异同点。所举例句具有典型性和实用性，也贴近生活，便于读者学习、记忆和引用。

4. 在各同义词条下，附有该组同义词的反义词，以便读者通过反义词的联想加深对英语同义词的理解、应用和记忆。

5. 科技词汇多，所涉及的科技例句也多。

随着我国对外开放的不断扩大，英语学习蔚然成风。本手册的出版，相信能对广大读者学习英语有较大的裨益。

由于我们的水平有限，本书一定有不少缺点和错误，我们热切希望广大读者批评指正。

## 使用说明

1. 每组同义词用黑正体列出，首先给出英文词，其后用括号中的缩略词给出该组词的词性，接着是该组词的中文意义。同一个词有不同意义的，分别列于不同的同义词组中，依先后出现的顺序在右上角标以1、2、3、4等数码。

2. 对同义词词组中各词分别给出辨析和例句，讲到某一个词时，某个词首先用黑正体标出，在例句中，该词以白斜体出现。

3. 在每组同义词的最后给出该组词的反义词，反义词也用黑体印刷。

4. 手册前面的同义词词组索引依正文的顺序给出各组同义词及其中文意义，手册后面的单词速查索引按英文字母的顺序给出本手册所讲解的同义词。
