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

## 坚如大漠石的精神 (代序)

借着在北京昌平区旅游企业创建青少年旅游科普教育基地的 机会,让我走进了位于流村镇古将村的大漠奇石馆,使我有幸结 识了大漠奇石收藏家魏进学先生。

走进奇石馆,映入眼帘的则是千姿百态、造型生动、变化万千的世间万象。蓝色的玛瑙、紫色的水晶、红绿碧玉、雪白的玉髓、黑色的玫瑰、棕色的集骨、五光十色……真是无奇不有,美妙绝伦。在这之前我从没有见过也没有听说过这么多好看的奇石,于是,我就有了想了解这些奇石,想了解魏先生其人的愿望。

1948年,魏进学先生出生在冀中平原上的河北蠡县,从学生时代,就对石头产生了浓厚的兴趣,几十年工作中,他当过兵,做过成功的企业家。十五年前,为了这个爱好,他毅然放弃了其他工作,走上了艰难的藏石之路。魏先生用四年时间四次深入内蒙古的巴彦淖尔盟、阿拉善盟一带,累计行程8000余公里,收集了近四十辆大卡车的奇石。环境的恶劣,路途的险阻,甚至是对生命极限的一次次挑战,都没能动摇他收集大漠奇石的信心和决心。他是用生命在谱写一段藏石的传奇文化。

正所谓石如其人,人若其石,大漠石的特点是硬、真、朴,搞不了假。魏先生何尝不是这种性格呢!记得在大漠奇石馆落成剪彩仪式上,朋友劝他换下满是泥土灰尘的衣服,他说:"石头是自然的,我本人也就是这个模样,因为每天都要整理我的石头,拥抱我的石头。"

是啊!魏先生爱石如命,成为世间少有的"石痴"。整天和石头对话,就像生活中不可缺少的人生"伴侣"。我常和他开玩笑说,他本人就有着一张玛瑙脸,可以说石头就是他的"魂",他把每一块石头常看成是一幅画、一首诗、一支歌。

当我们问到他,为什么要建馆,还要对游人开放?他说: "独赏不如共赏,让大家都欣赏,大家的心情才能得到愉悦,不 就更好吗?"

对于成长中的年轻一代,欣赏奇石又是一个很好的科普教育形式。它带来的不仅是视觉上的惊艳,还有对大自然鬼斧神工的慨叹,在丰富了知识的同时,又学习到其中所蕴含的奇石精神。从而更加热爱我们的家园,珍惜这带给我们神奇之旅的地球。正如魏先生建馆的初衷——"独乐乐,不如众乐乐!"既然如此,何乐而不为呢?!

# Spirit as Hard as Han Stone (Preface)

Taking the chance of setting up the Youth Tourism & Popular Science Education Base in tourism enterprises of Changping District, Beijing, I had an access to the Desert Rare Stone Museum in Gujiang Village, Liusha Town and got acquainted with Mr. Wei Jinxue, a collector of desert rare stones.

Stepping into the museum, I was fascinated with the various shapes, styles, forms and colors of rare stones, such as blue agate, purple crystal, read and green jasper, snow white chalcedony, black rose marble, brown jigu stone, etc. What a fabulous picture there! Before this visit I had never heard or seen such wonderful rare stones. Thus I came up with a desire to know more about them as well as Mr. Wei.

Mr. Wei Jinxue, born in Li County, Hebei Province of Jizhong Plain in 1948, developed an interest in stones when he was a student. During decades of working experience, he was ever an army soldier and then a successful entrepreneur. In the pursuit of this hobby, he gave up career 15 years ago and began to collect rare stones. He spent 4 years' time paying four in-depth visits to Bayannaoer League and Alasan League of Inner Mogolia, totally covering over 8,000 kilometers and collecting nearly 40 trucks of rare stones. Harsh environment, dangerous road, or even severe challenges to the limit of life could not conquer his confidence and great determination. He has been composing a legend history of rare stones with his own life.

It is said that collectors and their stones interact. The characteristics of desert stones are hard, genuine and simple, which exactly summarizes Mr. Wei's personality. On the ribbon-cutting ceremony of Desert Rare Stone Museum, though Mr. Wei's friends tried to persuade him to change his dusty clothes, he refused, saying, "The stones are natural and so am I. I am what I look right now, for I have to deal with my stones every day."

Mr. Wei values stones as his own life and becomes a stone addict rarely seen in this world.

He talks with the stones as if they are integral life companion of his. I used to joke with him that he has a face looking like agate. Stone is simply his soul and he regards every single piece as a painting, a poem or a song.

When we asked him why he set up the museum and allowed visitors to access, he answered, "To appreciate beauty by oneself is not as good as to share beauty with others. Isn't it a better idea to bring happiness to others?"

For the younger generation, appreciating rare stones is also a good way to spread popular science education, which not only amazes their eyes with nature's marvels, but enriches their knowledge and enables them to exploit the included spirit of rare stones as well. Thus they will love our home more, and better cherish the globe where they live. Just as Mr. Wei's original intention indicated, "Rather than oneself happy, why not make everyone happy?" Doesn't that make more sense?

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### 大漠奇石的成因、欣赏与收藏

随着国内外收藏热的不断升温,奇石收藏也是异军突起,在国际拍品中也常见奇石的身影。在我国和亚太地区,大漠奇石收藏在收藏界也似如一朵盛开的奇葩,日新月异!

亿万年前,由于内蒙、新疆独特的地质结构和地壳错位、变迁、火山爆发以及风吹、沙砺等原因,在浩浩大漠和苍苍戈壁,经严酷的大自然洗礼,在每块石头上都留下了岁月的精华,造就了数以万计美轮美奂的大漠精灵。人们赏之愉悦、如梦如幻、神韵无穷。在收藏界,人们给它起了几多很好听的名字:有人叫它大漠石;有人叫它戈壁石;有人叫它风砺石;也有人叫它风凌石。只有新疆统称它为大漠石。大漠奇石涵盖玛瑙、碧玉、玉髓、千层石、玄武岩、硅化木等,其多数是硅质类奇石,硬度在6.5-7.0度。

"石不能言最可人",爱石藏石,既能满足人们崇尚自然、返璞归真的心态,陶冶情操和生活上得到高雅精神享受,又有收藏、观赏、科研、传世和日益显现的经济价值。在奇石收藏中,判断一方大漠奇石的好坏、有无收藏价值,要从它独具的特点中,着重看它的质地、形状、色彩和意境几方面因素。

质地: 质地是指奇石的化学成份和物理性质, 也是评定一方奇石价值的重要 因素之一。一块硅质的玛瑙玉石与一块灰质、沙质岩的山石相比, 就好似金子与 铜之比, 大漠奇石绝大部分品种质地为硅质。密度越大, 质地纯者为上品。由于 它硬度大、质地坚硬, 人工不易打磨,即使有一点打磨或修整, 人工痕迹也会一 目了然, 因此, 做假、赝品对大漠石而言, 难!

形状:形状对于一方奇石而言是衡量它是否有无收藏、观赏的重要标准之一。形态多姿、造型奇特、气势恢宏是大漠奇石的第二大特点。它的外形千姿百态,形象万千,天上、人间、人物、动物、鱼虫花鸟的造型在大漠奇石中应有尽有。造型奇特、叫人过目难忘的为精品,更上档次精品,不但形似而且神似,以至能达到逼真的程度。

颜色:颜色会使奇石增奇和宣染主题。色彩丰富、润泽是大漠奇石的第三大特点。由于大漠奇石含有不同的矿物成份,所以它有单色和复色之分,单色纯洁略显剔透,复色艳丽流光溢彩。更神奇的大漠奇石绝品,在它形似、神似的造型中,还能同时"克隆"出象形物的各部颜色,以神奇叫绝天下!

近年来,收藏上几件附有"黑里红"和"熟蟹红"色沙漠漆的大漠奇石,是个值得炫耀的话题。在此画册中,这样的沙漠漆比比皆是,可谓沙漠漆荟萃!

意境:意境对于一方奇石而言,似如人有无灵魂、精气神一样。一块好的大漠奇石,应该是越看越耐看,它意境之渊、神韵之美,会令人神驰意远,这也正是大漠奇石的第四大突出特点。由于大漠奇石生成年代久远,所处人烟稀少的大漠戈壁,亿万年中无人访扰,天时地利人和加之鬼斧神工的自然力量,使它形成了富有灵性、世间无奇不有、色彩丰富、千姿百态的形状。

大漠奇石,珠光宝气、流光溢彩!它是雄浑大漠、浩荡戈壁,在独特的地理环境和严酷的大自然洗礼下,被注入了大漠戈壁魂的大自然产物;它,历经磨难而坚韧、大雅大俗而超然;它,奇在鬼斧神工、贵在天然造化、美在千姿百态、妙在举世无双。大漠奇石,奇石收藏者的最爱!



# Formation Cause, Appreciation & Collection of Desert Rare Stones

As collection is becoming more and more popular both home and abroad, the collection of rare stones appears as a new force that suddenly arises. You can even see them among international auction articles. In our country as well as Asia-pacific region, desert rare stones are also like a fantastic flower full in blossom and growing with time in the collection circle.

Hundreds of millions of years ago, due to the unique geometrical structure and some other causes such as lithosphere dislocation, transition, volcanic eruption, wind blow, gravel, etc. in Inner Mongolia and Xinjiang, tens of thousands of marvelous desert "genii" came into being over the vast Gobi desert, with years' essence left on every single piece of stone through harsh natural development. People feel refreshed when appreciating them, as if they were in a dream full of lasting charm and appeal. In collection circle, they are favorably named as desert stones, or Gobi stones, or fengli stones, or fengling stones. Only in Xinjiang they have one unified name, desert stones. Generally desert rare stones include agate, jasper, chalcedony, qianceng stone, basalt, silicified wood, etc, most of which belong to siliceous category, with hardness ranging from 6.5 to 7.0 degrees.

"The stone that cannot speak deserves utmost love from people". To love and collect stones satisfies people's demand to admire nature and return to the original simple past, nurtures people's sentiment with elegant spiritual enjoyment, and brings increasingly obvious economic value in terms of collection, appreciation, scientific research and inheritage. In rare stone collection, to tell a desert rare stone good from bad, with or without collecting value, largely depends on several factors out of its unique features, i.e. texture, shape, color and artistic conception.

Substance: substance refers to the chemical composition and physical property of rare stones. It serves as one of the essential factors to judge the value of rare stone. Comparing an agate of silicon substance with a stone of gravel or sand substance, is just like comparing gold with bronze. Desert rare stones are mostly of silicon substance. Top grade is always with greater density and purer substance. As it is hard, difficult to grind or finish, even a little bit of grinding or trimming would make labor traces clear at a glance. Thus it is more difficult to cheat on desert stones.

Shape: shape is one of the essential standards to judge a rare stone if it is of collection or appreciation value. Various forms, odd shapes and imposing manner are the second outstanding feature of Desert rare stones. A rare stone may have every shape or image that one expects to find, like the heaven and the world, people, animals, fish, insects, flowers and birds, etc. Those in odd shape that impress people at a glance are exquisite stones, while others with similarity in both shape and spirit to a vivid degree are of even higher rank.


Color: color can add oddness to rare stones and exaggerate the theme. Rich in color and glitter is the third feature of desert rare stones. Due to different mineral composition they have, the color includes single shade and compound shade. Single shade looks pure and slightly transparent while compound shade has flowing colors and glitters. More amazing is the one which has similar shape and spirit and meanwhile "clones" exactly every color of different parts as the original.

In recent years, it became a topic worth showing off to collect several desert rare stones with "black and red" or "cooked crab red" desert paint. Such desert paints can be found everywhere in this album, which can be called a constellation of desert paints.


Artistic conception: conception is to a rare stone what soul or spirit is to a man. For a good desert rare stone, the longer you look at it, the more charm and appeal you'll find. Its broad artistic conception and wonderful verve makes you relax and think far beyond, which is said to be the fourth feature of desert rare stones. Long years of formation, special location in the Gobi desert with few human habitation, free from visits or disturbance throughout hundreds of millions of years, and influence from climate, geographic position, people's support plus great natural force, all of which enable the desert rare stone to form spiritual, odd, colorful and various shapes.

With flowing colors and glitters, desert rare stones are natural result embedded with Gobi spirit through all harsh and severe tests of nature in the unique geographic environment of Gobi desert. They become tough and resilient with all hardships, and detached with elegance and convention. Featuring in nature's creation and formation, various shapes, as well as unique conception, the desert rare stones are the most loved ones of extensive collectors.
