前言

《网络教育大学英语考试大纲词汇手册》是根据全国高校网络教育考试委员会制定的2007年修订版《大学英语统考课程大纲》,专为网络教育学生而编写的工具书。它同时也适用于同等文化程度的英语学习者。本书旨在帮助读者学习和掌握英语词汇,提高他们运用英语进行学习和交流的能力,是他们学习英语、参加考试和提高英语应用能力的必备参考书。

本书收录了 2007 年修订版《大学英语统考课程大纲》词汇表的所有词汇。各词条除给出英式音标和汉语释义外,还均配有地道实用的典型例证,以便读者学习、揣摩和品味。所有词目和例证均配有 MP3 录音,以便让学习者做到听读相辅,在强化记忆大纲词汇的同时,练习听力和口语,切实提高运用英语进行现实交际的应用能力。




