要学习英语,了解西方文化,《圣经》是逃不开、躲不掉的。至少,不了解西方人常引用的《圣经》中的事件、人物、典故和说法,会令你如坠五里雾中。

一种文化要向外渗透和扩大影响,很大程度上是通过这种文化的代表 作品或经典作品,而《圣经》正是西方文化中的代表和经典。

人们要了解和走进一种文化,方法很多,但比较而言,最简便的方法 是了解这种文化的为数不多的经典。

一种文化的少数几部经典是这种文化中根系最发达、枝叶最广阔、树冠最高大的林中标志性大树,找到这棵大树就找到了那片林子,进林子的路也就好走了。



《圣经》在西方的影响可说是无所不在。单就文学和艺术而言,举其大者,不了解《圣经》中的名篇、典故和名言,弥尔顿、莎士比亚、拜伦的许多诗歌,拉斐尔、米开朗琪罗的绘画和雕塑,你就无法欣赏。



西方人的价值观念、生活习俗和举止谈吐,都常常反映出《圣经》的影响,或者从中可以找到根据。岂止西方,像中国人耳熟能详的"旧瓶装新酒"(new wine in old bottles)和"披着羊皮的狼"(wolf in sheep's clothing),人们已经是那么熟悉,甚至不觉得它们原来出自《圣经》了。可见,真正优秀的文化遗产,既是民族的,更是世界的。

在注重素质教育的时代,我们想为大、中学生和其他读者提高西方文化素养、更好地学习英语做些基础性工作,于是我们组织编写了此书。但读者也许会问,坊间已经有那么多讲《圣经》故事或典故的书了,我们的努力岂不多余?恰恰相反,我们发现,符合广大英语学习者的需要,领他们《圣经》入门的书还真不多见!因此,我们要做的,就是化难为易的工作,即通过通俗化、大众化,降低《圣经》这部经典著作的难度,使我们的读者有信心、有勇气走近《圣经》和感悟《圣经》。至于进去了还走不走或还走多远,那就要靠读者自己了。

#### 《圣经》是怎样一部书啊!

一提到《圣经》,人们马上联想到基督教。但《圣经》的历史比基督教的历史要久远得多,大部分《圣经》内容早在基督教诞生之前就已经出现了。以《旧约圣经》为基础的宗教就有三个,即犹太教、基督教和伊斯兰教。

《圣经》这部古老经籍,是希伯来民族文化的宝贵遗产,它记载了古代中东乃至南欧一带的民族、社会、政治、军事等多方面情况和风土人

情,其中的哲学和神学观念孕育了犹太教、基督教和伊斯兰教,并随着基督教的广泛传播,给世界,尤其是西方的社会发展、意识形态和文化习俗带来巨大影响。而且,《圣经》不仅是重要的文学著作,也是艺术、建筑、音乐等其他杰作的孵化器。西方历史上许多伟大的文学家、艺术家、建筑家和音乐家,都是在《圣经》精神的感召下,创作出流芳百世的不朽之作。

《圣经》在中国的影响也可谓不小。只举两个例子:早在明朝万历年间,意大利传教士利玛窦 (Matteo Ricci)就来到中国,传播天主教。当时笃信程朱理学的中国士大夫,有许多觉得他讲的有道理,就接受了天主教。而且随着西方传教士的到来,中国的上层知识分子,包括皇室,开始了解到西方的天文、历法、几何等近代科学,进而促进了中国近代科技的发展。清朝洪秀全领导的太平天国革命,虽然是当时中国社会阶级矛盾激起的一场农民起义,但他创立的"拜上帝会",也是受到西方天主教的启发。

《圣经》是世界上被翻译的语言最多、流传最广的一部经典,被视为人类历史上最有影响的书籍。严格说来,《圣经》并不是一部书,而是 66 部书的汇集,其中最早的可能写于公元前 1000 年左右,最晚的可能写于公元 150 年左右。所以,即使逃不开,躲不掉,作为普通读者,也只能花有限的时间去熟悉《圣经》中非熟悉不可的一部分,并从中学习英语,增长智慧。



最后想特别提一下的是,任何经书,由于在历史的长河中被太多的人 带着虔诚的心情反复阅读,并出于信仰把它们运用于生活的各个方面,试 图用它来指导生活,结果本来十分平淡朴实的原话,经过读者心灵的放

大,可能变得十分饱满而富有寓意。经书的这种"微言大义"的现象,一方面说明了经书的生命力,另一方面也给其他文化中的读者带来困惑。比如"上帝将硫磺与火降于所多玛和蛾摩拉",这里的硫磺与火已不再指这两种东西本身,而是指任何毁灭性的惩罚或灾难;"所多玛和蛾摩拉"也不再只指历史上的两座城市,而成了任何罪恶渊薮的代名词。

所以我们在阅读《圣经》这部异域经典时,应张开自己心灵的翅膀, 开放地思索而不是拘泥于字面,要将其植根于现实生活,由此及彼地加以 理解,这将有助于我们咀嚼出更多的滋味来。语言和文化之间有一种类似 于骨头和汤的关系。没有骨头当然做不出好的骨头汤,但是要获得真正的 营养和滋味,却不能只啃骨头不喝汤。

我们衷心希望您能从这本书里,既啃到了骨头,又喝到了汤!


