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前 言

笔者有幸多年讲授许国璋主编《英语》1——4册(1979年重印本)。在教学实践中,我们发现,学生对这套教材虽然比较熟悉,似乎也掌握了教材中的语法规则和基本词汇,但仍然不能应用已学语言知识做好看来应该答正确的英语试题。究其原因,主要是缺乏系统的实践练习而阻碍了语言应用能力及应试能力的提高。其次,许多学生虽然非常重视实践练习,但由于他们所做的有些试题不十分对路,缺乏系统性,结果往往感到收效不大。此外,我们还发现,学生在做题时,对一些较难辨析与选择的试题经常感到茫然无策,从而响影了对某些较难语言现象的掌握。

正是上述原因促使我们根据原教材编写了这本附有难题注释的自测辅导用书,供大学英语专业自学考试参加者、大学英语专业学生,各类使用这套教材的学习者以及广大英语爱好者自测参考之用。如果它能助学习者一臂之力,我们便感到无限宽慰。

本书共分为四大部分。第一册的练习构成第一部分,主要测试第十三课至第二十四课的语法与基本词汇;第二册、第三册和第四册的练习分别构成本书的其它三大部分。其中,每册练习又以原教材的阶段复习课为界限各分为三部分测试内容,以便利于学习者结合教材有目的、有系统地进行自测。第二册的练习主要涉及本册的语法和基本词汇;第三
