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#### 内 容 提 要

本书是一本旨在提高考博英语词汇水平的复习资料。它根据《研究生教学大纲》和众多名校的考博英语大纲,并结合历年考博英语试题,精选出考博英语核心词汇约8000条。每个单词都有相对应的试题,以达到语境记忆、记练结合的目的。试题来源于考博英语真题,或与其难度水平相当的国内外英语考试试题,或经过对国外一些权威杂志、文章整理、改编而成,试题主要针对单词的考点而设置,如近形词、近义词及常用搭配等,具有很强的实用性和针对性。

所选考博英语核心词汇重难点突出,代表性强,既可作为一本词汇手册,又可作为练习考题的复习资料。本书特别适用于参加博士研究生人学考试的考生,对于参加考研、职称英语、博士学位、GRE、GMAT等其他英语考试的考生而言,本书也具较好的参考价值。
