前 言

《新编英语泛读教程1-4册参考答案》是《新编英语泛读教程》的配套用书,供高等学校英语专业一、二年级泛读课教师使用。

《新编英语泛读教程》所选用的语言材料内容涉及英语国家的社会、政治、经济、文化、历史、新闻、宗教、体育、医药、文学、风土人情、科普知识等各个领域。该教材全套四册。每册十八单元,按阅读方法编为三到四组。每一单元分三个部分。

第一部分(Section A)包括词汇测试(Word Pretest)、课文(Text A)、词汇练习(Vocabulary Building)、完形填空(Cloze)等。这一部分在编写时是为课堂教学设计的,一般不要求学生预习,但是教师可根据学生的实际水平灵活掌握。比如说,由于这一部分练习量较大,教师可要求学生在不阅读课文的前提下,对部分练习项目进行预习,以提高教学和学习效果。

第二部分(Section B)主要供学生课外阅读,其课文内容是对第一部分课文相关题材的深化或补充。设置这一部分的目的是为了增加学生的阅读量,以弥补目前缺少合适课外阅读材料的不足。

第三部分(Section C)由三至四篇短文组成,主要用于快速阅读的训练。教师可根据学生的具体情况对所规定的阅读时间进行适当调整。

《新编英语泛读教程》每一单元共有6-7篇同一题材的文章。教师可以根据这些文章的内容和难易程度,灵活处理,在课堂上有选择地进行讲解。

《新编英语泛读教程》属阅读教材,但在教学过程中,教师应鼓励学生开展课堂讨论。为此目的,我们在每个单元的最后准备了两至三个思考题。教师也可以组织学生就各单元题材分头准备作专题发言,这样既扩大了学生课外阅读的面,又提供了锻炼口语的机会。

《新编英语泛读教程1-4册参考答案》在编写过程中得到了上海外语教育出版社庄智象老师、江雷红老师的指导和支持,他们对本书的编写提出了不少宝贵的建议,在此表示衷心的感谢。

欢迎使用《新编英语泛读教程》及《新编英语泛读教程 1—4 册参考答案》的同志批评指正。
