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行业英语

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内 容 提 要

随着我国信息产业的国际化进程日益加快,IT行业对精通英语和技术的复合型人才产生了巨大需求。要系统提高我国IT类专业学生和IT从业人士的实际英语综合技能,从而提高我国IT行业的整体国际竞争力,我们需要建设一个系统、科学的教学与教材体系,帮助学习者掌握他们在IT企业中应该具备的英语技能。

《IT行业英语》教材以一名刚刚走出校园,并加入一家IT公司的大学应届毕业生为主线,将虚拟人物Leo在IT企业中所接触的各类常见技术场景进行汇总,并按照主题设计了10个教学单元。每个教学单元分为听、说、读、写4个模块,其中听、说模块的比例占60%,阅读模块占30%,写作模块(E-mail写作)占10%。与传统教材相比,该教材具备了行业性、实用性、时效性与交互性等多方面优势,旨在培养、提高学习者的行业英语应用能力。

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前 言

为了满足社会和企业对高校毕业生英语技能的要求，高校英语教学模式、内容与教材建设都在不断地进行着变革与发展。随着外企的不断本土化和本土企业的日益国际化，各类企业对员工英语水平的要求将越来越趋于专业。尤其在外企，与外籍管理人员的沟通涉及大量行业英语的运用；而针对性不强、定位不够清晰的传统通用型英语教育无法满足各类企业员工对日趋专业化的英语技能的需求。按行业领域进行划分的行业英语教育，则因其强化对外交往及职业化技能，而成为当今白领和毕业生的新需求。因此，行业英语教育将成为大学英语教学体系中一个不可缺少的组成部分。

近十年来，我国信息产业的国际化进程日益加快。中国 IT 产业以其巨大的市场潜力、大量优秀的人力资源 and 显著的地域成本优势在全球 IT 行业正扮演越来越重要的角色。越来越多的国际 IT 企业逐渐将研发与生产基地向中国转移；众多中国 IT 企业向国际市场的拓展也代表了中国 IT 产业走向世界的趋势；同时众多为外企和出口市场服务的软件外包型企业也如雨后春笋般出现。如上诸多因素使 IT 行业对精通英语和技术的复合型人才产生了巨大需求。然而，在如此巨大的行业需求下，中国大学毕业生的行业英语能力却在面临着巨大的挑战甚至质疑。

“中国每年新培养出约 60 万名工程师，是美国的 9 倍。然而，在中国 160 万名年轻工程师中，只有约 16 万名具备为跨国公司工作所需的实用技能和语言技能。10 年后，中国将需要 7.5 万名具备某种国际经验的经理人。中国目前仅有约 5000 名此类人才。”

“只有不到 10% 的工科毕业生能够胜任在国际化企业工作，毕业生缺乏实践经验和英语口语水平差的状况使中国难以发展以服务为基础的产业。如果中国软件专业的本科和研究生毕业生英语水平不高的话，这些企业进军国际市场的举动可能会毫无意义。”

如上引用的麦肯锡研究报告和评论客观地指出了我国高校英语教育体系存在的问题。经过对行业需求与高校英语教育现状的仔细分析，我们认为，如果要系统提高我国 IT 类专业学生和 IT 从业人士的实际英语综合技能，从而提高我国 IT 行业的

整体国际竞争力，我们就需要有一个系统的、科学的教学体系，建设一门有益于学生提高英语实用技能的课程，帮助学生学习到他们在 IT 企业里面该具备的英语技能，也为企业培养合适的人才。因此我们开始着手编写《IT 行业英语》教材。

《IT 行业英语》教材共分为 10 个单元，其主要内容以一名刚刚踏出校园，并加入一家 IT 公司的大学应届毕业生为主线。Leo 是一名计算机专业的大学毕业生，刚刚加入一家名为 MacroTech 的 IT 公司。本教材将虚拟人物 Leo 在 IT 企业中所接触的各类常见技术场景进行汇总，并按照主题设计了 10 个教学单元。每个教学单元分为听、说、读、写四个模块，其中听、说模块的比例占 60%，阅读模块占 30%，写作模块（主要为 E-mail 写作）占 10%。

本教材专门针对 IT 类专业的大学生或英语自学者所编写，难度适中，适合作为 IT 行业英语的入门级教材。今后课程组将围绕主人公 Leo 在公司内的职业发展，继续编写适合更高技术与管理层面的《软件工程师英语》教材。

《IT 行业英语》是课程组在面向 IT 产业的行业英语教育方面所作的首次尝试。书中难免会有疏漏之处，敬请各位读者、同行不吝指正，以使这本教材臻于完善。

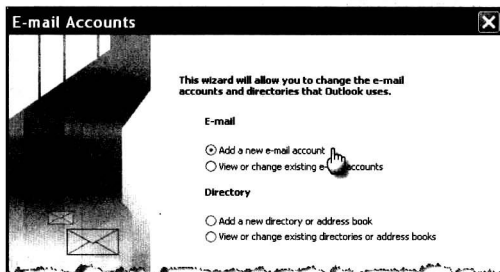
Sample: 1.1 Add a New E-mail Account in Microsoft Outlook

Leo: Tony, could you tell me how to receive e-mails on my own computer? It takes too much time to check e-mails on the web site, since I do it quite often.

Tony: You don't have to log on to the web site every time. You can receive your e-mails with Microsoft Outlook.

Leo: Can you tell me how to do that? I have no clue at all.

Tony: After running Outlook, you can first click **E-mail Accounts** on the **Tools** menu. And then select **Add a new e-mail account**.



Leo: I see. What type of e-mail server should I choose?

Tony: In this case, you need to choose **POP3**. And on the next page, in the appropriate boxes, you need to type the information our administrator gave you, such as your e-mail address, user name, password, and the POP3 and SMTP server addresses.
