

前言

FOREWORD

这是英雄辈出的时代!这是被誉为"现代英雄"的实业家们大展鸿图的时代!《恒星——中外实业家荟萃》正是在这一时代应运而生。

本书遴选了60家中国大陆、台湾、香港和外国企业的优秀决策者,并将他们的创业事迹和成功之道介绍给读者。他们中既有白手起家、敢为人先的创业者,又有临危受命、转危为安的守业者;既有身先士卒、兵法治厂的"武官",又有满腹经纶、运筹帷幄的儒将。他们不同的经营特色,迥异的成功道路,向人们展示了中外实业家各领风骚的迷人风采。



1979 年 10 月 4 日,以荣毅仁为首的 16 人组成的中国国际信托投资公司正式宣告诞生。该公司虽直属国务院,但它悄无声息的成立却没有个体商店开张时那样气派。本来国家要给公司拨款的,但是荣老板偏偏要自筹资金。

要印些信封信笺,买点笔墨纸砚,可是,当初就连这些小支出的经费也没有,是荣董事长的夫人杨鉴清女士取出个人存款 1000 元借给了公司,才救了急。这 1000 元,可称得上是中信的第一笔资金了。

那时,中信公司虽然资金少,人手缺,办公用房紧,但是工作气氛十分严谨、和谐。在荣毅仁董事长带领下,大家团结合作,有事抢着做。 天早 8 点上班,7 点 30 分人就到东天早 8 点上班,7 点 30 分人就到东京。晚 6 点下班,可一点没有下位现高思。荣毅仁董事长和其他几位尽力,从来没有正点下过班。尽有奖金,上下班没有班车,中对没有食堂,可公司职工就是凭着对自己改革开放政策的热情和引进外资搞建设的勇气,自觉地工作着。
