PREFACE

考研英语怎么学?词汇掌握是基础,阅读理解是关键!

据教育部考试中心相关数据,近几年研考平均有37%的考生英语成绩未能过关。竞争是惨烈的,但也从另一个方面昭示我们在英语方面的不足。英语学习,从根本上来说,要在保证一定学习时间的前提下,采用正确的学习方法和合宜的参考资料进行复习,其复习重点就在于平时对词汇的积累掌握和对阅读的攻克。而考研备考时间紧,任务重,能否在短时间内将这两个学习重点一举攻克?

本书正是以解决这一难题为目的编写而成的,我们更在原版的基础上,将内容进行了大幅修订,将更臻于炉火纯青的词汇记忆方法和精辟独到的难句讲解融为一体,使您在词汇与难句的互动学习中,一举两得,冲刺得标。

读者在阅读中经常会遇到这样的情况:明明单词都认识,可整个句子就是读不懂。原因之一就是单词的一词多义没有掌握全面,熟词变成了生词,从而影响了阅读的速度和质量。在近几年的考研试题中,命题人员明显加强了对这一方面的考查,许多考生在这方面的能力明显不足,甚至深受其困,尤其在阅读与翻译题中,往往因一个单词的词义理解有误而导致大量的丢分。有鉴于此,我们以解决读者的学习难点为出发点,投入大量的时间和精力把大纲中所有的熟词生义遴选出来供读者学习,帮助读者击破盲点,清除熟词陷阱。

●用法详解

在研究生入学考试的关键词下列有相应的"用法",内容包括动词、介词搭配,形容词的位置,句子结构,易错易混词等各方面。

比如,你想知道 the aim of doing sth. 为什么不对;"对某人很诚实"是用 be honest with sb. 还是用 be honest to sb.; numerous 修饰单数名词和复数名词在意义上有什么不同; cheat 和 deceive 有何区别; access, assess, excess 如何区分等等,都可以在本书中找到答案。

三、精选的长难例句、真题例句——边记边读, 词汇与阅读两不误

词汇是基础,阅读理解是关键,除去生词外,长难句就是阅读中最大的难题。为此,本书单挑历年考研全真试题中的长难句和最新的英美时文报刊长难句。这些长难例句不仅可以使读者在语境中加深对单词的记忆,而且能够提高读者的阅读理解和翻译能力,边记边读,边读边记,使词汇与阅读两不误。

需特别说明的是,本书在部分重点词条下新增真题例句,全部精选于近 10 年的考研真题,让读者在更为逼真、权威的实战语境中记忆单词。






