《大学英语听力理解 500 题》是《大学英语考试专项训练》系列 从书之一。

本套丛书根据《大学英语教学大纲》和《大学英语考试大纲》以及新题型要求,按照试题类型分册编写而成。旨在帮助广大考生和英语自学者抓好英语基本功训练,巩固英语基本知识,熟悉如何考核。学生通过大量的试题实践操练,可望达到巩固提高自己的语言能力,顺利通过考试的目的。取材广泛,内容新颖,题目训练题之大,可谓是本套丛书之特色。
