

## EINLEITUNG.

Die nachstehende Arbeit enthält die Beschreibung der eoza-  
nen Säugetiere, die in den Jahren 1921—1923 durch die unter den Aus-  
pizien des Schwedischen China-Kommittes vorgenommenen Aufsammlungen zu-  
sammengebracht worden sind. Die Arbeit gliedert sich in einen systematischen Teil,  
in dem die verschiedenen Formen ohne Rücksicht auf Alter und Fundort behandelt  
werden, und den stratigraphischen Teil, in dem die einzelnen Fundorte behandelt und  
das Alter der Ablagerungen besprochen werden. Dieser Teil wird etwas lückenhaft  
erscheinen, denn obwohl ich im Verlaufe der Sammeltätigkeit alle Fundstellen selbst  
besucht habe, habe ich damals nicht erwartet, mich auch selbst mit ihrer Geologie  
befassen zu müssen, und daher nur äusserst knapphändige Aufzeichnungen gemacht.  
Der systematische Teil behandelt, wie man sehen wird, so gut wie ausschliesslich  
Zahnmaterial, denn obwohl an manchen Fundstellen auch Skeletteile in ziemlicher Menge  
vorhanden sind, ist es mir im Allgemeinen nicht gelungen, dieselben den verschiede-  
nen, durch ihre Bezahlung belegten Formen zuzuweisen. Es trägt hieran nicht nur der  
unzureichende Umfang der mir zu Gebote stehenden Vergleichssammlungen die Schuld,  
sondern auch die sehr summarische Behandlung, welche diese Teile in der überwie-  
genden Mehrheit der paläontologischen Arbeiten erfahren haben.

Es ist mir ein Bedürfnis, allen denen meinen wärmsten Dank auszusprechen, die  
mich auf die eine oder andere Weise in der Durchführung dieser Arbeit unterstützt
