# 高等学校 英语应用能力考试 综合练习

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## 前言

自从在全国范围实施高等学校英语应用能力考试以来,高等学校英语应用能力考试已成为全国性的高职高专大学英语考试的重要形式。本书紧扣国家教育部高等教育司颁布的《高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲》和《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》(试行)而编写,旨在提高学生的英语应用能力,帮助考生顺利通过高等学校英语应用能力考试。

本书覆盖面广,题型丰富,注重专项训练,分为词汇、语法、阅读理解、翻译和写作五部分。是教学一线的教师根据高职高专学生英语学习的特点,总结教学实践的成果。希望通过使用本书,考生都能够快速提高英语应用能力,顺利通过高等学校英语应用能力考试。

本书由盛湘君任主编,王敏、张连娇任副主编,童燕琴、陈晓霞、熊艾莎编写。此外,蓝俊芳、潘爱琴、楼淑娟等为本书的编写做了大量的工作。

由于编者的水平有限,书中若有疏漏之处,敬请广大教师学生批评指正,以便进一步修改完善。

## 高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲 (B级)

## 一、考试对象

本大纲适用于修完《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》(试行)(以下简称《基本要求》)B级所规定的全部内容的高等职业教育、普通高等专科教育、成人高等教育和本科办二级技术学院各非英语专业的学生。

## 二、考试性质

本考试的目的是考核考生的语言知识、语言技能和使用英语处理有关一般业务和涉外交际的基本能力,其性质是一种教学水平考试。

## 三、考试方式与内容

考试方式为笔试,包括五个部分:听力理解、语汇用法和语法结构、阅读理解、翻译(英译汉)和写作(或汉译英)。考试范围限于《基本要求》B级所规定的全部内容。

## Part I Listening Comprehension

测试考生理解所听问题并做出恰当回答的能力、理解简短对话的能力和听写词语的能力。听力材料的语速为每分钟 100 词。

听力材料以日常交际和简单的业务交际内容为主。词汇限于《基本要求》的"词汇表"中 B 级 2,500 词的范围,交际内容涉及《基本要求》中的"交际范围表"所列的 B 级听力的范围。

本部分的分值占总分的15%。测试时间为15分钟。

#### Part II Vocabulary and Structure

测试考生运用词语和语法知识的能力。测试范围限于《基本要求》中的"词汇表"B级(2,500词)和"语法结构表"所规定的全部内容。

本部分的分值占总分的15%。测试时间为15分钟。

## Part III Reading Comprehension

测试考生从书面文字材料获取信息的能力。总阅读量约800词。

本部分测试的文字材料以一般性阅读材料(科普、文化、社会、常识、经贸、人物等)为主,也包括简单的应用性文字,不包括诗歌、小说、散文等文学性材料,其内容能为各专业学生所理解。

阅读材料涉及的语言技能和词汇限于《基本要求》中的"阅读技能表"中与 B 级要求相应的技能范围和"词汇表"B 级中 2,500 词的范围;阅读材料涉及的应用性内容限于《基本要求》中"交际范围表"B 级所规定的读译范围,如:便条、通知、简短信函、简明广告、简明说明书、简明规范等。

主要测试以下阅读技能:

- 1. 了解语篇和段落的主旨和大意;
- 2. 掌握语篇中的事实和主要情节;
- 3. 理解语篇上下文的逻辑关系;
- 4. 了解作者的目的、态度和观点;
- 5. 根据上下文正确理解生词的意思;
- 6. 了解语篇的结论:
- 7. 进行信息转换。

本部分的分值占总分的35%。测试时间是40分钟。

## Part IV Translation-English into Chinese

测试考生将英语正确译成汉语的能力。所译材料为句子和段落,包括一般性内容(约占 60%)和实用性内容(约占 40%);所涉及的词汇限于《基本要求》的"词汇表"中B级(2,500 词)的范围。

本部分的分值占总分的20%。测试时间为25分钟。

## Part V Writing/Translation—Chinese into English

测试考生套写应用性短文、填写英文表格或翻译简短的实用性文字的能力。本部分的分值占总分的15%。测试时间为25分钟。

## 高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲 (A 级)

## 一、考试对象

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## 三、考试方式与内容

考试方式为笔试,包括五个部分:听力理解、语法结构、阅读理解、翻译(英译汉)和写作(或汉译英)。考试范围为《基本要求》对A级所规定的全部内容。

## Part I Listening Comprehension

测试考生理解所听对话、会话和简单短文的能力。听力材料的语速为每分钟 120 词。对话、会话和短文以日常生活和实用的交际性内容为主。词汇限于《基本要求》的"词汇表"中 3.400 词的范围,交际内容涉及《基本要求》中的"交际范围表"所列的全部听说范围。本部分的分值占总分的 15%。测试时间为 15 分钟。

#### Part II Structure

测试考生运用语法知识的能力。测试范围包括《基本要求》中的"语法结构表"所规定的全部内容。

本部分的得分占总分的15%。测试时间为15分钟。

### Part III Reading Comprehension

测试考生从书面文字材料获取信息的能力。总阅读量约1,000词。

本部分测试的文字材料包括一般性阅读材料(文化、社会、常识、科普、经贸、人物等)和应用性文字,不包括诗歌、小说、散文等文学性材料,其内容能为各专业学生所理解。其中,实用性文字材料约占60%。

阅读材料涉及的语言技能和词汇限于《基本要求》中的"阅读技能表"所列的全部技能范围和"词汇表"中3,400词的范围;除一般性文章外,阅读的应用文限于《基本要求》中"交际范围表"所规定的读译范围,如:函电、广告、说明书、业务单证、合同书、摘要、序言等。

主要测试以下阅读技能:

- 1. 了解语篇和段落的主旨和大意;
- 2. 掌握语篇中的事实和主要情节;

- 3. 理解语篇上下文的逻辑关系:
- 4. 对句子和段落进行推理;
- 5. 了解作者的目的、态度和观点;
- 6. 根据上下文正确理解生词的意思;
- 7. 了解语篇的结论;
- 8. 进行信息转换。

本部分的分值占总分的35%。测试时间是40分钟。

### Part IV Translation-English into Chinese

测试考生将英语正确译成汉语的能力。所译材料为句子和段落,包括一般性内容和实用性内容(各约占50%),所涉及的词汇限于《基本要求》的"词汇表"中3,400词的范围。






