前 言

不久前,在井冈山召开了五省大学英语研讨会,与会者一致认为,外语教学的前沿就是如何培养和提高学生的外语素质。因此,今后要加强听、说、读、写、译的全面教学,注重培养学生运用语言的综合能力。

为了适应新的形势,适应新时期培养具有较好英语素质的英语人才的要求,帮助大学生顺利通过全国大学英语四级考试,我们编写了《最新四级考试词汇1000例详解》一书奉献给广大考生及一切英语爱好者。期望此山之石能攻它山之玉。全书共分两大部分:第一部分为最新四级考试词汇模拟测试(共二十六套);第二部分是答案与详解。本书具有四大特点:

- 一、"全"。本书词汇模拟范围全。根据国家教委公布的《大学英语考试大纲》、《样题》和大学英语四级考试新题型,本书设计了词汇专项测试题,全面反映了《教学大纲》和《考纲》对词汇教学的宗旨和要求。
- 二、"真"。本书力求使每道试题的难易度都和实际考题一致,每套题与实际考题的词汇测试题量一致。材料大多选自最新英、美书刊,语言规范,表达准确。兼顾科学性与实用性,把大学英语四级考试词汇测试的特点展现在考生面前,使他们能把握住要点,尽早通过大学英语四级考试大关。
- 三、"细"。本书对词汇测试题进行了精心细致地设计,并 给出了尽可能详尽、准确的解答,使考生对考题不仅知其然, 而且知其所以然。

四、"准",即考试指导方向准。本书以培养和提高考生的

语言综合运用能力、实践能力为出发点,从《考纲》词汇表中筛选出 1000 个级常考重点词汇,进行模拟精练。无论从选词、题型的设计,还是从问题的解答上看,本书都真正反映了考生对四级考试词汇复习的实际需要。因此,我们相信,只要考生按照《教学大纲》和《考纲》的要求,认真模拟训练本书的试题,一定会取得成功!

本书适合参加大学英语四级考试的广大英语考生,同时 对参加其它高级英语水平考试的考生、其它英语爱好者和英 语教师,本书也具有一定的参考价值。

由于水平有限,加之时间仓促,书中失误疏漏之处在所难免,恳请同仁及广大读者批评指正。
