前 言

《九年义务教育英语课程标准(实验稿)》指出: "语言技能是构成语言交际能力的重要组成部分。语言技能包括听、说、读、写四个方面的技能以及这四种技能的综合运用能力。听和读是理解的技能,说和写是表达的技能; 这四种技能在语言学习和交际中相辅相成、相互促进。学生应通过大量的专项和综合性语言实践活动,形成综合语言运用能力,为育实语言交际打下基础。"然而,众所周知,我国的英语教育。一位美国语言学博士曾跟我说,有一位托福考了640分的中国硕士曾跟他练习口语,可他俩很难沟通。这位中国硕士曾跟他练习口语,可他俩很难沟通。这位中国硕士自动此之差,以致这位美国博士说自己真不知道他是怎样考的托福640分。事实上,不只这位硕士如此,就是我们的一些英语老师有时也怕与外教接触。虽然他们的英语法很好,但他们听、说的能力有限,怕听不懂、怕说不出,怕闹笑话。

我们以往的英语教育在听、说方面重视不够,也没有很好的语言环境。改革开放以来我们发现了这个问题,在教学中注意了这个问题。但由于种种原因,结果还是不理想。我们编写这套丛书就是想在这方面有所突破,力争能对读者有所帮助。

本丛书是按照《九年义务教育英语课程标准(实验稿)》的"等级要求"和"话题项目表"编写的。本着循序渐进的原则,从易到难;有的话题反复使用,但难度越来越大。第一册为三级,供七年级使用;第二册为四级,供八年级使用;第三册为五级,供九年级使用。

本丛书的编写原则是: 1. 趣味性,要求对话内容能够吸引学生,学生愿意学; 2. 实用性,要求对话内容紧密结合学生生活实际,学生学了就可以用; 3. 现实性,即使用最新英语,内容设计出其不意。

本丛书每册 20 个单元,每个单元为一个话题,每个话题 分为: 1. 示范对话 (Model conversation); 2. 常用习语 (Useful phrases and expressions); 3. 自编对话 (Tasks)。

本丛书由有国外生活、进修经验的资深英语教研员和一线教师编写,由英国学者 David Marr Joss 审稿。本丛书的编写贴近生活、联系实际、符合学生特点、趣味性强、科学实用,是一套不可多得的口语训练丛书。通过此书的学习,可以振作学生的精神,启迪学生的灵感,增强学生的信心。
