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前 言

《医学英语快速阅读》是应高等医药院校在英语教学中培养阅读理解能力和提高阅读速度之急需而编写的。它除了作为医学生的英语快速阅读教材之外，还可供广大医务工作者自学和办英语学习班之用。

本书按难易程度分为三个单元，每个单元有文章五十篇。每篇文章之后有阅读理解题，书末附有参考答案。文章大多选自近年来出版的原文书刊，突出实用性、趣味性和医学倾向性。由于选材内容丰富，又分成各自独立的单元，所以，使用时可根据学员的实际程度和可能安排的时间自由选用。

本书部分内容曾在白求恩医科大学、吉林医学院、中国人民解放军兽医大学和长春中医学院试用过。经过教学实践进一步精选提炼，又充实了大量的新资料，使本书更加完善。本书编写组由六人组成。采保庚主持全面编写工作，负责全书设计、组织选材、协调进度和质量把关。马汉英侧重于校阅和修改稿件。文中词语注释和阅读理解题等部分分别由张言朴（负责1—11等38篇）、滕玉梅（负责12—20等38篇）、张玉娟（负责21—29等37篇）、关丽娟（负责39—44等37篇）编写。编写过程中，李春昌等同志给与具体指导和支持，邓修竹同志和美籍专家Ross A.
