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英語常用詞用法

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- a [ei, ə], an [æn, ən, n], (an 用於母音或不發音的子音前)。adj. 或 indefinite article.
 - 1. 一,一個。I can see a boy, an old man, and two dogs. 我能看見一個男孩,一個老人和兩隻狗。
 - 2. 任何一個。A dog is a faithful animal. (=Dogs are faithful animals.) 狗是忠實的動物。
 - 3. 某一。A Mr. Li came to see you this morning. 今早有一位李先生來看你了。
 - 4. 同一。These cups are all of a size. 這些杯子都是同樣大小的。
- 5. 每,各。He comes here once a week. 他每星期來此一次。

able ['eibl], adj. (後面常接用有 to 的不定詞)。

- 1. 有能力的。I may be able to (=can) see you tomorrow. 也許明天我能夠見到你。
- 2. 能幹的,有才幹的。He is old but still quite able. 他雖老能 力尙强。

about (ə'baut), prep.

abroad (ə'bro:d), adv.

absent. ('æbsənt), adj. (其名詞爲 absence ('æbsəns].)

- 2. 不注意。I asked him a question but he looked at me in an absent way and didn't answer. 我間他一個問題,但他心不在焉地望着我沒有回答。
- 【运意】absentee [æbsn'tiː] 爲缺席者,不在場者。 absent-minded 爲不注意的,心不在焉的。

accept [ək'sept], v. (反對字篇 refuse.)

account (ə'kaunt), n.

 - 3. 理由,原因。Don't tell him on any account. (=for any reason). 在任何理由之下,都不要告訴他。

【注意】on account of, prep.=because of. 因爲

accuse (ə'kju:z), v.
