




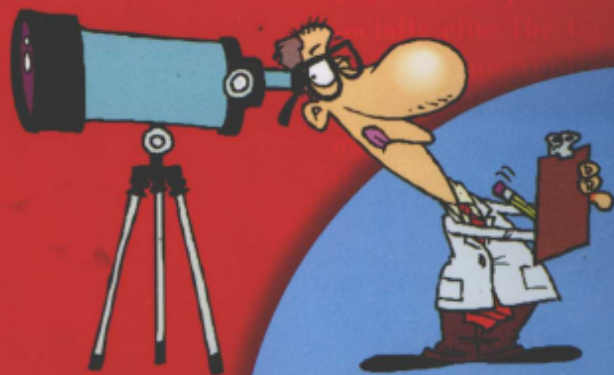

Harvard, Yale, and Princeton set up a league, consisting of four universities, with the "Ivy League". If the Roman numeral IV is looked at in letters, it can be pronounced as the same pronunciation as the word "ivy" in English. The advantage of Ivy League universities is that they have many world-famous professors and also have an illustrious academic heritage. They have very high admission standards, the Ivy League universities are still the place where many outstanding students desire to attend. They are a haven for the country's top-tier students and faculty and they are perceived to be the elite of the Ivy League.
