开发背景

第一版《大学实用英语》自 2003 年正式问世以来,受到全国(特别是中西部地区)广大师生的热烈欢迎和认可,大家普遍认为这套教材能紧扣《基本要求》(即教育部颁布的《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》,书中简称《基本要求》)和《高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲和样题》的要求,在重视语言质量、打好学生语言基础的同时,特别突出了实用性、趣味性、信息性、思想性,为课堂教学提供了丰富的素材,使老师有充分的发挥余地。不少师生称赞这套教材结构严谨、选文题材丰富、富有时代气息,符合了职业教育对知识和语言应用的需求。老师、同学们的称赞和认可对我们编者是极大的鼓舞和激励,我们表示由衷的感谢。

六年来,我们也不断收到一些师生对教材的不足提出的批评和修订建议,这些 批评和建议都是中肯、很富建设性的。为此我们委托江西科学技术出版社的编辑 同志在全国范围内组织召开了数次大专院校专家、教师们的研讨会,集中倾听和收 集他们的意见和建议。综合大家反馈的意见后,我们对教材结构、知识体系、选文 题材做了全面的调整,经过历时一年半的准备和紧张的编撰,推出了这套新版《大 学实用英语》。

新版教材的特色

一、涵盖范围更广、针对性极强。

我国的职业院校学生人校英语水平跨度特别大,语言基础显得参差不齐。本

套教材为入校基础薄弱的学生在两方面做了改进:(1)在知识点选择上先以复习初、高中知识为主,由浅入深;(2)讲解上力求深入浅出,即便在后期学习比较难的知识点时,也通过比较详尽、浅显的叙述来启发学生,尽可能弥补基础的薄弱。这种改进,尤其是我国中西部地区的学生在初高中阶段英语水平相对较浅,以及我国高职规模迅速发展的原因,导致了高职高专学生入校时英语基础相对较差,因此,我们教材修订后,力求尽量满足这批学生的需求。而且,对于一些的中等职业院校也比较适用。

教材的重点放在针对人学基础一般的高职高专学生身上,为此教材紧扣《基本要求》和《高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲和样题》,所规定的所有知识点在本套教材中均得到了较好的反映。学完本套教材的第二级可以参加"高等学校英语应用能力考试"的 B 级考试,学完第三级可参加 A 级考试。所以,从这个角度说,教材也达到了多数高职高专学生学习的目标要求。

对于学有余力的学生,同时也为与本科院校接轨,教材设置了第四级,主要是根据教育部颁布的《大学英语教学大纲》和《大学英语四级考试大纲》编写而成。

二、结构更加科学,"听"、"说"、"读"、"写"、"译"比例合理,知识点循序渐进。

教材共四级,每级配备了综合教程、听说教程、教师用书、练习册、多媒体教学光盘、电子教案、录音磁带,共七个部分。

综合教程每册含 10 个单元,每个单元中分四大模块:Communicating,Reading,Grammar,Merry Learning。其中每单元的 Reading 元由三篇课文组成,课文 A 为精读材料,配有阅读理解、词汇词组、完形填空、英汉翻译、写作等多种练习。课文 B 为泛读材料,并配有阅读理解练习题,供学生们课外阅读。课文 C 突出英语应用能力训练,按照《基本要求》编写,由浅人深,有日常交际能力训练和业务能力训练。涵盖了《基本要求》中所提到的各种信函、外贸单证、经贸合同等高职高专学生将来就业常用的应用文。这四大模块就包括了"说"、"读"、"写",而将"译"融于Text A 后的练习中。

听说教程是围绕综合教程的主题展开,力求使学生在"听"、"说"两方面进一步得到专门训练。

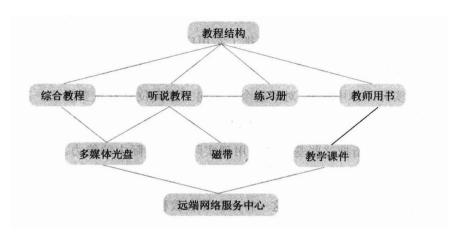
三、内容更加突出实用性,同时兼顾了趣味性、信息性、思想性。

- 1. 注重实用。首先,本教材非常注重对学生语言技能和应用能力方面的培养,为此特意在各级的 Text C 中安排了实用应用文的学习,这些应用文涵盖了从书信、应用信函(如求职信、请假条等)、产品说明到简易外贸单证、合同书,种类近70种,均从实际工作中选材,对学生今后走向工作岗位具有重要意义。其次,教材将英语应用能力的训练体现于实用英语能力的培养之中。应用能力既指应用语言基本功的能力,更指把这些基本功运用到实际涉外交际中的能力。教材十分注意"应用能力"和"实用能力"的关系,即"应用能力"是"实用能力"的基础,"实用能力"则是"应用能力"的具体体现。这一特点在综合教程的课文 C 中明显地表现出来。
- 2. 内容浅显易学、趣味性强。本教材选文紧扣日常工作、生活,听力注意选用一些趣味性强的材料,如故事和歌曲,使学生轻松愉快地溶入学习气氛中,从而提高学习积极性,提高学习效果。为此目的,编者们耗费了大量的时间进行选材,筛选留用了一些有实际意义、实用性强、时代特色鲜明、学生熟悉的话题和文章,使学生愿意学、愿意说、愿意练,从而实现教育部《基本要求》。

教材的结构体系

《大学实用英语》(第二版)在结构体系上突出了立体构架、多元教学的思想。主要包含:

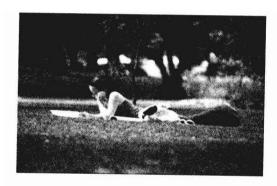

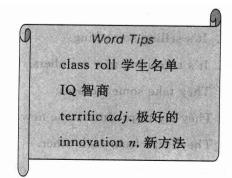
