



# 用美剧学习英语

#### ● 陷入美剧漩涡的美剧一族

美剧热风头正劲,甚至一度出现了"美剧一族"和"美剧废人"这样的专有词汇。当然,这股美剧热最初源于电视剧的带动,但是我们更希望看到美剧热转化为英语学习的热潮。"post 应试英语"时代提倡"英语听说",从这方面来讲,美剧是最好的英语学习资料。美剧是美国电视剧的简称,美国电视剧能够真实再现美国生活,因此它是一种不用亲临其境也能最大限度体验美国生活的英语学习资料。尽管偶有例外,如 CSI(《犯罪现场调查》)这样的美剧就反映不了日常生活,但是,像 Friends(《老友记》)、Desperate Housewives(《绝望主妇》)和 Sex and the City(《欲望都市》)这种主要以日常对话为主的美剧,就称得上是英语学习宝库中的珍宝。

#### ● 用美剧快速提升英语能力


现在,我们欣赏美剧,就如同将美国搬到自己家中一般生动鲜活,但随之而来的疑问——如何学习英语——却挥之不去。会说的语句听不懂,听得懂的语句又不会说……有些人知道美剧有帮助,就按照别人推荐的方法,在不看字幕的情况下练习听和写。但这也只适用于有一定英语基础的人,对于其他人而言,则好比让只爬过小山的人去攀登珠穆朗玛峰般不切实际。为此,我们向英语基础较弱的学习者推荐如下学习方法:

- 1. 阅读阶段: 观看美剧时, 阅读字幕。→熟悉日常英语表达方式。
- 2. 学习阶段: 学习大量美剧英语语句。→原本跟不上的人物对话仿佛放慢了速度般—— 入耳。
- 3. 实战阶段: 学会美剧语句后,练习听无字幕美剧。→渐渐听懂更多的单词和语句,对掌握美剧英语产生信心。

释义 This means "I didn't expect to see you." It is a way of saying that one person surprised the speaker by being somewhere unexpected.

A: Geez, you startled me! What are you doing

强化 You got that? 你听懂了吗?

A: You need to be at the airport at 7 a.m.. You got it?

你早晨七点要到机场,听懂了吗?

B: Sure, I got it. I'll be there on time. 哦,知道了,我会准时到达的。





Are you with me on this? 听懂了吗? So are you with me or not? 你站在我这边吗? / 你支持我吗?

# I get the point. 我知道什么意思了。

释义 This usually indicates that the speaker has completely understood something. It is a way of saying "I see what you mean."

强化 You take my point? 听明白我的意思了吗?

A: I don't want anyone smoking in this building.

我不希望任何人在这幢楼里抽烟。

B: I get the point. I won't do that. 知道,我不会的。

# Do I make myself clear?

听懂我的话了吗? / 理解我的话吗?

释义 This is asking "Have you understood?" The speaker wants to know if everyone has understood something important that was said.

强化 I didn't make myself clear. 是我没有说明白啊。

A: I don't allow cell phones to be used in class.

Do I make myself clear?

上课时间不准使用电话,听懂我的话了吗?

B: But sir, what if there is an emergency call from my parents?

但是,老师,要是父母打过来紧急电话呢?



Did I make myself clear? I'll say it again. 听明白我的话了吗?我再说一遍。

I'm going to need a little bit more compensation. Do I make myself clear? 我需要更多一点儿的补偿,你明白我的话吗?





# Is that clear? 明白我的话吧? /知道什么意思吧?



释义 This is similar to previous phrase. It is asking if an important thing the speaker said was understood. It is like asking "Did you understand what I said?"

A: I don't ever want to see you again. Is that clear?

我再也不想见到你,听懂了吗?

B: Fine! Here is your engagement ring back. 好啊! 拿走你的订婚戒指。

You can't have a vacation this year. Is that clear? 你今年没有休假, 听懂了吗?

# Get the message? 听懂 (什么话) 了吗?

释义 This is a somewhat rude and curt way of asking if someone understood something clearly. It means "Do you understand what I said?"

A: Sara, why don't you ever talk to me anymore? 萨拉, 你为什么不愿意和我说话了?

B: Because you're a loser. I don't like you. Get the message? 因为你是个笨蛋,我不喜欢你,听懂了吗?

# Don't you see? 你不知道吗?

释义 Often this is a way of asking a person "Can't you understand?" The speaker may not be sure if someone understands something.

强化 Don't you see how / when S + V? 你不知 道·····吗? (= Isn't it clear that S + V?)

A: How are we going to get enough money to buy a house? 我们怎样才能有足够的钱买套房子啊?

B: Don't you see? We'll both have to get jobs and save our salaries.

你还不知道吗?我们两个都要工作,积攒工 资才行。




This won't help, don't you see? 这不管用, 你不知道吗?

I do love you. Don't you see? Don't you understand? You're the love of my life. 我 爱你。你不明白吗?不知道吗?你是我的 今生挚爱。
