

本书内容说明

本套丛书按照词汇的"难易度"共分为三册六级,每册分为两级,每级收录1000多个词汇。《基础英语词汇 2000》收录其中 Level 1及 Level 2 的单词,《进阶英语词汇 3500》收录 Level 3 及 Level 4 的单词,《流利英语词汇 6000》则收录Level 5 及 Level 6 的单词。经去芜存菁,并加上重要衍生词汇后,三册总词汇量大约 6000个。

为避免研读时可能产生的枯燥无趣感,我们以日常生活词汇出现的频率为依据,将难度属于同一级的单词依照单词的频率排列,最常出现的单词在前,最不常出现的单词在后,每个单元各收录约 40 个单词,以利读者吸收消化。我们相信本套书由浅入深、循序渐进的编排,绝对能提供同学最完整、最系统化的学习。
