## 序言

#### 陈素芝

首次专业技术职务评聘工作,经过复查验收,现已告一段落,职称改革工作开始转入经常化阶段。总结几年来评聘工作的经验教训,在今后的职称改革中,必须坚持聘任制的方向,坚持评聘标准和任职条件,既要重视科研成果,更要重视实际工作的政绩,坚持考试、考核与评审有机结合的原则。只有这样,才能保证专业技术职务的评聘质量,维护职称改革的声誉,从根本上克服"评滥、评乱"的积弊。

坚持评聘标准必须严格掌握外语条件。应当看到,我国在经济、文化方面与发达国家相比客观上还存在差距。要缩小以至消除这一差距,实现我国经济和社会发展的长期战略目标,需要我们付出极大的努力。贯彻改革开放的方针、扩大对外交流与合作,认真学习、吸收国外先进的科学技术和管理经验,都需要广大专业技术人员学好外语,熟练地掌握外语,这是历史的要求。所以,按照国家人事部对全国统一的部署,我们省将统一进行高、中级专业技术职务外语考试。它对于提高专业技术人员的业务素质,确保专业技术职务评聘质量将会起到积极促进作用。当然,在外语考试或考核工作中,根据国家下发的专业技术职务《条例》的要求,我们对不同职务系列和不同职务层次将有不同要求,特别对长期坚持基层工作和老年专业技术人员既要严格要求,又要实事求是,区别对待。

为了使专业技术人员准备外语考试时有所依循,由辽宁省职称改革工作领导小组办公室组织有关方面的领导、专家、学者编写了这套《辽宁省评聘专业技术职务外语考试教材》,经过编著者的辛勤努力和征求各方面意见,已由辽宁大学出版社正式出版了,这是一件很有意义的事。相信《考试教材》的出版对于提高全省专业技术人员的外语水平是会有所裨益的。

# 前 言

《辽宁省评聘专业技术职务外语考试教材》经过编著者的辛勤努力,现在与读者见面了。这套教材的出版发行,对于提高全省专业技术人员的外语水平,贯彻省职改工作领导小组关于在全省统一进行高、中级专业技术职务外语考试的决定,具有积极的意义。

根据国家人事部《关于在专业技术职务评聘中严格掌握外语条件的通知》(人职发[91] 4号)要求,我省决定从1992年开始,在全省统一进行高、中级专业技术职务外语考试(初级职务的外语考试由各市和省直各部门自行组织,使用本教材)。考试试题采取题库形式,语种分为英、日、俄语。考试专业相对分为文、理、工程、农业、医药、财经六个方面。考试试题按水平分为A、B、C、D、E五个等级。凡《试行条例》有外语要求的系列人员的正高级、副高级、中级职务之晋升考试外语(翻译人员和高校专业外语教师考试第二外语)按辽职改字[91] 17号文件规定适用相应等级。此外,专业技术人员聘期期满也要考核外语,作为续聘的参考依据。全省专业技术职务外语考试时间定在每年8月最后一个星期天9—11时。经考试认定符合外语条件的人员,由省职改工作领导小组办公室制发《专业技术职务外语考试合格证书》,三年内参加评聘专业技术职务有效。考试不合格人员可参加下年度的外语考试。各专业技术人员应根据上述有关规定和本人所学语种及所从事的专业选择相应教材。

《辽宁省评聘专业技术职务外语考试教材》共十八册,包括:文科英语、理科英语、工程英语、财经英语、农学英语、医学英语、文科日语、理科日语、工程日语、财经日语、农学日语、医学日语、文科俄语、理科俄语、工程俄语、财经俄语、农学俄语、医学俄语。英语、日语教材还配有录音磁带。考虑到目前专业技术人员外语水平的实际情况和建立试题题库的需要,每册教材包括以下4个组成部分:1.基础语法;2.外文文选及参考译文;3.试题样题;4.单词表。

希望广大专业技术人员充分利用这套教材,切实提高自己的外语水平。同时也要正确处理工作和外语学习的关系,防止因学习外语或突击培训而冲击、干扰各项生产、工作的正常进行。

选派专家、学者参加教材编写的单位有:大连外国语学院、东北财经大学、大连理工大学、东北工学院、辽宁大学、沈阳师范学院、沈阳农业大学、辽宁农业科学院、中国医科大学、沈阳工业大学、沈阳工业学院、大连医学院。在本套教材的编写过程中得到了国家人事部有关同志的热情帮助,陈素芝副省长为本套教材撰写了序言。本套教材在编写过程中,还得到了省有关部门和各市职改办的大力支持,对教材提出了很好的修改意见,在此一并表示感谢。

由于本套教材编写时间仓促,教材中不妥之处在所难免,希望广大读者批评指正,以便修订。
