前　　言

学英语,贵在掌握词汇,并对常见单词的运用能融会贯通,《新编英语反义词词典》的推出,旨在为英语四、六级应试者、英语专业学习者及提高英语水平的托福考试者、雅思考试者、GRE 考试者、从事翻译的工作者和教师提供参考。

大家知道,一本好的词典就像一名优秀的老师,会教给你许多知识,但是,词典有许多种,各有其用。英语中称为 antonym 的反义词词典是一种十分有用的独具特色的词典。它是中级、中级以上英语学习者认识单词、掌握单词,增加词汇量的又一捷径;它不仅实用、特殊、有趣,更能使我们把学习英语的触角伸展得更广,同时还能敏锐地掌握文字的感觉。我们深信:此书的推出将为更多的读者开启一条路径,体味和领悟学习英语的一些方法与技巧,从而提高英文写作能力。

英语中的反义词数目庞大,范围极广。本书收录了近 3000 对反义词(包括附录中的短语或词组 270 多对),涉及的反义词近 10000 个,例句近 12000 条,同时,我们也收录了与主单词意义相近或相同的同义词 13000 个,这些都是在各种水平考试中出现频率最高、大众化的单词,可经常活用于日常生活中。

6. 明暗、色彩相对的词：

dark 暗的 → light 明亮的

black 黑的 → white 白的

7. 其他反义词：

dwarf 侏儒 → giant 巨人

war 战争 → peace 和平
