The man looked at the old woman for a few seconds. Then he looked at the clerk---and then he took his keys, ran out of the bank, got into his car and drove away quickly, without any money.







English breakfast is a very big meal eggs, tomatoes, tea, coffee ...

For many people lunch is a quick meal. On Sundays many families have a traditional (传统的) lunch. They have chicken, pork...with potatoes, vegetables...



High school students take only four or five subjects each term. They usually go to




