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### 编写说明

《新核心大学英语词汇手册》单独出书有两个目的:一是把《读写教程》、《泛读教程》和《听说教程》的生词以单元为单位进行汇总,便于学生能够系统地学习和查找某一个主题里经常出现的词汇;二是通过各种词汇练习形式,让学生充分操练和掌握各单元出现的词汇,不仅是《读写教程》里的词汇,而且包括《泛读教程》和《听说教程》里的词汇,以便大幅度提高学生的词汇量。

《新核心大学英语词汇手册1》分八个单元。每单元由四部分构成:第一、读写教程词汇;第二、听说教程词汇;第三、泛读教程词汇;第四、词汇综合练习。第一部分读写教程词汇是学生必须掌握的重点部分,因此给出了单词读音、词性和简短的中英文解释等较为详细的释义项目。第二部分听说教程词汇和第三部分泛读教程词汇的注释相对简练,仅仅给出单词读音、词性和对应的汉语解释,学生通过练习做到能够辨认即可。三个部分的所有词汇都进行了分类标注。其中,一般要求词汇不加任何标记;积极词汇标记为◎;较高要求词汇标记为★;更高要求词汇标记为▲;超纲词汇标记为◆;学术词汇标记为私;更高要求词汇标记为人;超纲词汇标记为◆;学术词汇标记为私;使用的词汇,也是托福、雅思和GRE等考试中的核心词汇)。

第四部分有五种练习形式,分别是:选词填空(30题)、选词配义(30题)、短语翻译(20题)、同义词匹配(10题)、辨别不同类词(10题)。出题的原则是侧重读写教程词汇。选词填空部分主要针

对读写教程词汇;答案词和干扰项之一均来自读写词汇表。选词配义部分的下划线词从每单元词表中来,读写教程词汇表和听说、泛读词汇表的出题比例是20:10。短语翻译部分考查学生汉译英的能力,其中读写教程词汇表和听说、泛读词汇表词出题比例是15:5;同义词匹配以列表方式给出,其中左栏词从每单元词表来,读写教程词汇表和听说、泛读词汇表的出题比例是5:5。辨别不同类词部分的核心意义词从每单元词表来,读写教程词汇表和听说、泛读词汇表出题比例是5:5。本书附有练习答案,供师生参考使用。

本书在词汇列表和词汇综合训练的设计上,考虑到学生不同层次的需求及对题目趣味性的要求;注重发挥学生思维的关联性和发散性,让学生在选择、辨析和翻译的过程中对词汇温故知新。同时词汇手册突出一个"简"字。词汇介绍力求简短准确,题干设计尽量选择最常用的句子。"简"并非是简化或草率,目标是惜时和有效。删繁就简,希冀此书成为学生随身携带的实用性词汇手册。
