英语阅读理解从形式上来看可分为广义上的阅读理解和狭义上的阅读理解。广义上的阅读理解,即通过对一篇文章、一段对话,甚至一个句子的阅读,以达到理解之目的。在现代各类考试中的表现形式有:完形填空、阅读理解、短文改错、补全对话、短文填空等。狭义上的阅读理解就是我们常见的一种"阅读理解"题目,这种阅读理解题目的表现形式又可细分为回答问题、正误判断、单项选择、完成句子、任务型阅读等。

我们推出的"飞越阅读"系列丛书,就是按两种阅读理解形式而编写,即"飞越阅读•周周测"和"飞越阅读•每日一篇"。这两套丛书可同时使用也可单独选用。

"飞越阅读·每日一篇"丛书仅按常见的阅读理解题型,即狭义上的阅读理解进行编写,它包括初中和高中两个部分。每个年级分为两册,每册分为20套,一周一套,从星期一至星期日每日一篇训练题。每套训练题综合各类教材内容,按照最新课程标准、英语教学大纲及考试大纲要求编写,注重针对性、实用性,内容丰富、选材广泛、原汁原味,部分来自于美国之音。本丛书有利于读者突破阅读瓶颈,领略地道英语的无限魅力,进而全方位提高英语水平。

当然英语阅读水平的提高,还需要同学们在平日里练习时培养良好的阅读习惯,掌握正确的答题技巧。下面就本丛书的使用作一些提示:

- 1. 阅读前迅速查阅每个小题题干和选项所提供的信息,预测短文的内容,这样就能有的放矢,提高答题的准确率。
- 2. 注意短文的信息及段首句,因为文章的首段和段首句往往对短文内容有提纲挈领的作用。
- 3. 阅读短文时,注意力要集中在整体内容的理解上,而非个别单词或单句上;同时克服犹豫不决的毛病,对没有把握的题目在已知信息的基础上迅速进行优化处理。

书中所有阅读内容的答案和解析都以活页的形式置于书后,老师若需对 学生进行测试,可将每本书的答案和解析内容取出来,然后再给学生订正。 这样的编排有利于广大师生应用自如。




Many people like animals and keep one or more pets — dogs, cats, or some kinds of birds. If you keep a dog or a cat as a pet, you must know how to look after them.




