# 前 言

在大学英语教学和测试中,听力理解往往是学生最感吃力、丢分较多的部分。根据几年来的教学实践和辅导学生参加六级考试的实际工作中,使我们感到:要提高听力理解能力,多听是必要的。应结合听力测试的重点和难点,循序渐进地学习一些听力技巧,多做一些有针对性的训练,培养学生有意识地进行积极的联想、对比、分析、猜测和判断的能力,就能使学生在较短的时间内,迅速提高听力理解和应试能力。

随着大学英语四级考试通过率的不断提高,参加六级考试的学生也在逐年增加,大学英语六级考试将会成为大学生关注的热点。为了更有效地参加六级考试,对每种题型应有充分的了解和训练。编者以《大纲》为依据,参照全国六级考试听力理解试题的内容和其他同类书的精华,编写出20套听力自测题。每套题的A节(Section A)是对话,共10组对话。B节(Section B)一般由三篇短文组成,每篇词数约为120—140个词,其后是10道题、每篇材料2—4题。每套题共20个小题(满分20分)。书后附有听力自测答案和听力原文,以便学生自我测试。本书配有外籍教师录制的磁带。

在众多六级考试练习册中,专门训练听力测试的书极为少见,你可使用本书进行自我测试,正确率达到 70%,便符合要求了。

愿本书为你的六级考试获得 20 分助一臂之力。
