

本书是根据《STCW78/95 公约》及马尼拉修正案和《中华人民共和国海船船员适任考试、评估和发证规则》的要求而编写的。全书共分 14 课,完整再现了一个航次,每课侧重介绍航行中的一个环节,具体内容包括准备登船、登船、装卸货、离港、值班、雾中航行、狭水道航行、消防演习、救生演习、遇险、过运河、进港、港口国检查和船舶保安等。

本书可作为高职高专交通运输类船舶驾驶等相关专业的教材,也可作为在职船员的参考书。

随着我国远洋运输事业的快速发展,国际航运市场的竞争亦日趋激烈,这就对远洋船舶驾驶员的英语听力和口语水平提出了更高的要求。为了适应《STCW78/95 公约》及马尼拉修正案和《中华人民共和国海船船员适任考试、评估和发证规则》的要求,编者在对有关法规进行认真研究的基础上,结合航海院校驾驶专业英语教学目标和远洋船舶驾驶员各级岗位的实际工作需要,编写了这本教材,以尽快提高远洋船舶驾驶员的英语听力和口语水平。

本书适合于具有一定英语语言基础的航海院校驾驶专业和远洋船舶在职船员使用,具有以下特点。

- (1)本书以一个完整的航次为编写顺序,包含了航行中可能出现的各种情况,完整再现了航行的真实环境。
 - (2) 添加了一定量的专业词汇和日常用语,为学习者将来交际打下基础。
 - (3) 词汇的覆盖率和常用词汇的复现率较大。
 - (4) 较全面地涵盖了驾驶员的主要业务工作内容。
 - (5) 循序渐进地加大练习力度,以达到提高学习者英语听力和口语水平的目的。
 - (6) 练习形式活泼多样,有单项选择、问答、填空、听写等不同形式。
 - (7) 录音以标准的美音或英音为主,发音清晰、语速适当。

本书由慕冰、李昕辉担任主编,卢伟、王婧担任副主编,刘丽娜担任主审。

本书共14课,每课包括4部分内容。其中第六、第十一、第十二和第十三课由慕冰编写,第三、第四、第五和第七课由李昕辉编写,第八、第九、第十和第十四课由卢伟编写,第一和第二课由王婧编写。
