





Foreword

How time flies! No sooner has the first volume of "A Commemorative Album of Building Projects donated by Mr. Run Run Shaw" rolled off the press than its second volume is in print. The latter records the second batch of donation projects by Mr. Shaw. Building after building and block after block of high-rises are vivid testimony of Mr. Shaw's noble patriotic spirit. These are monuments built with Mr. Shaw's philanthropy.

Valuing education has been a good tradition of the Chinese people. To a people who have recovered from poverty and numerous agonies, we need many things in many areas of development before we can become a prosperous and modern country. Yet what we find ourselves particularly deficient and needy in is undoubtedly talented people. Education is the fundamental way to improve the quality of the whole population, develop its intelligence, nurture talent and encourage creativity. As a successful entrepreneur, Mr. Shaw has accumulated several decades of experience in starting and running a business and he has a profound understanding of this need. Since 1985, out of a pure heart, he has made huge donations every year to assist the cause of education in China, making a distinguished contribution to the education and training of more and better talented people. Mr. Shaw's vision and generosity have won wide admiration from people of all walks of life on the mainland.

In 1987, Mr. Shaw again donated a generous sum of HK\$116 million to 15 notable tertiary institutions in China for the purpose of building libraries, teaching blocks, science halls, etc. These buildings, all carrying Mr. Shaw's name, have vastly improved the teaching and research environments of these institutions, achieving good results and earning wide approval and praises from staff and students. Those who have been involved in constructing the "Shaw Buildings" have used imagination

in their designs, quality materials, fine craftsmanship and top quality control, integrating artistic and functional values into wide-ranging styles. These unique high-rise buildings have resorted to different artistic forms to portray Mr. Shaw's noble spirit. They will encourage generation after generation of students to study hard and to reward Mr. Shaw's good intention with outstanding achievements.

Since the implementation of open-door reform policy, compatriots from Hong Kong, Taiwan and overseas have shown concerns about China's four modernizations through various means and channels. Many of them have donated to the cause of education in China. Mr. Shaw's contributions are like the high and magnificent looking Qunlun mountains calling for admiration and like the never-ending Changjiang bringing benefits to our successors. At the publication of the second volume of this Commemorative Album, I wish to express my admiration for Mr. Shaw.

前言

Introduction

The great Tang poet Du Fu (杜甫) once wrote these lines:

安得廣厦千萬間,大庇天下寒士俱歡顏

(Would I have thousands of rooms in grand halls, To shelter multitudes of poor scholars one and all.)

Du Fu's lines were famous but his wish had to remain a distant dream.

Now, twelve centuries later, Du Fu's dream is being fulfilled through the generosity of Mr. Run Run Shaw. In a series of donations over a decade, he has given to Universities and Institutes in China over 100 academic buildings and to primary and secondary schools over 300 halls. Every province, every metropolitan city in China boasts now of at least one Run Run Shaw Hall, and many rural districts proudly show off their new Run Run Shaw Schools.

That Mr. Run Run Shaw's lifelong work in cinema and television stems from his interest in education and art is well-known. What is less well-known is his devotion to the Red Cross and medical care services over the years. There has been an aversion amongst Chinese people to the donation of blood. It was Mr. Run Run's great achievement to have brought about a change in attitude in Hong Kong through the gradual process of education, starting with children in schools. Another example of his many contributions to health care is the development of a hospital in Hangzhou, a project which has always been close to his heart.

I have known Mr. Run Run Shaw for a little over ten years. I detect a steadfast sense of purpose behind his charismatic gentleness. Indeed his determined generosity in helping, year after year, all levels of Chinese education and health care is unprecedented in the history of mankind. His compassion and his gentle but firm magnanimity will provide a noble and lasting example for all of us to follow.
