leave /li:v/

指与某种关系或联系的终止，而本身并不隐含“离开”、“放弃”的动机或后果，不带倾向性。一个人 leave 他的国家，有可能是因为犯罪逃避起诉，也可能仅仅是因为去一个气候更适宜的地方。一个 leave 了妻子的男人仍可公开地给他妻子以经济支援，而一个 abandon 了孩子的母亲则完全放弃了对孩子应尽的义务。

She left music to study engineering.
